The 125th anniversary of diplomatic relations between France and Ethiopia and Ethiopia and France is celebrated this year which is the 125th anniversary of diplomatic relations. On March 20th 1897, Léonce Lagarde signed with Menelik II a friendship treaty between the two countries, recognizing the independence of Ethiopia. This treaty marked the beginning of a strong friendship, embodied in several domains.

Although the first contacts between France and Ethiopia predate 1897, this anniversary is an opportunity to celebrate the depth and diversity of our relationship for the past 125 years and also, to look towards the future, by highlighting the projects our two countries have conducted in common in different fields (cultural, political, economic or scientific).

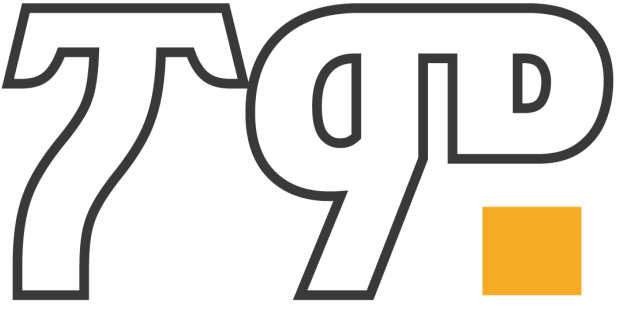

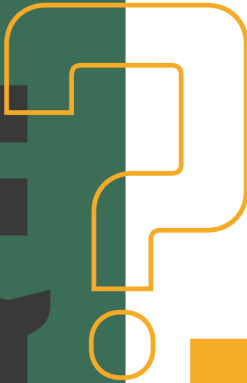

Working with our Ride the Rift colleagues in partnership with Oromia Tourism to explore the Rift Valley around lakes Langano, Shala & Abijata. Some great outdoor adventures are in the making.

The adventure biking potentials of Oromia are drawing attention as a group of foreign bikers and adventure tour operators explore parts of Western Arsi on their bikes. Cycling along the coast of the beautiful lake Langano, the group discovers how the rugged and diverse landscapes that characterize the Great Rift Valley hold some of the best adventure biking routes anywhere.

ARTIST AND POET PROFILE: KEBEDECH TEKLEAB.

Kebedech was born in Addis Ababa but she arrived from a concentration camp in Somalia where she had been a prisoner of war for 10 years. When she left Ethiopia in 1979, she was only a high school student, but was also an active member of a student-led political movement. As the junta hunted the activists, Kebedech and a few friends fled Addis Ababa on foot for a 600 mile journey through the Ogaden desert to Djibouti. But a long simmering border dispute between Ethiopia and Somalia flared into a full-blown war. Kebedech and her friends were captured by Somali soldiers in the desert and confined in the most dismal conditions. It was bare and colorless. She says of those years, "cruelty and selflessness lived side by side." It was the beginning of her training as painter and poet.

In 1989, Kebedech Tekleab arrived in Washington with a book of poems and clarity of purpose. She was going to be an art student and she would not live passively in the face of injustice. She enrolled in Howard University where she earned both her Bachelor and Master of Fine Arts degrees by 1995. After graduation, Kebedech worked as a studio artist in the greater Washington, DC metropolitan area and taught at several institutions, including Howard University and Montgomery College. In 2008, she moved to Savannah Georgia and joined the faculty of the Savannah College of Art and Design (SCAD). In 2016 She moved to the Art department of CUNY-QCC, where she is currently teaching.

She is a published poet, painter and sculptor. Her selected shows include exhibits at the National Museum of African Art, Smithsonian Institution in Washington, DC; the Illinois Holocaust Museum and Education Center in Skokie, Illinois; the Sidney Mishkin Gallery, Baruch College, New York City; and the Addison Reply Gallery in Washington, DC. Her commissioned and collected works are on permanent display at several institutions, among them the Illinois Holocaust Museum and Education Center in Skokie; the Navy Memorial Archives in Washington DC; the American Embassy in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia; and the Ethiopian Embassy in Washington, DC.

GOLD MEDALS ■

"We came to Belgrade aiming to make history for Ethiopia," So said Selemon Barega and indeed they did.

The Ethiopian domination of the men's 3000m continued with an eighth gold and a second successive 1-2 in the event, Selemon Barega emerging victorious from a last-lap sprint with compatriot Lamecha Girma in the final morning session at the World Athletics Indoor Championships Belgrade 22. Four years ago in Birmingham in 2018, Barega had to settle for silver behind Yomif Kejelcha but that was when he was an 18-year-old junior still learning his craft. Four years on, with an Olympic 10,000m gold and world 5000m silver back home, the 22-year-old had too much strength and speed when Girma attempted to launch an attack on the back straight of the final lap, crossing the line 0.25 clear in 7:41.38.

It was a slow burner of a contest, Barega moving to the front after the opening lap and leading the field to 800m in 2:04.20. At the bell Barega was back in front with six others still in the hunt but none of them could match him – even Girma. "I have had a good season, so I was ready both physically and mentally to fight for gold. It was a tough race in which we were focused mostly on the Kenyan guys," Barega said. And so the Ethiopian with the awesome range found himself emulating his celebrated compatriots Haile Gebreslassie and Kenenisa Bekele as an Olympic champion at 10,000m and a world indoor winner at 3000m.

Ethiopia also won Gold and Bronze medals in the women's 3000m title on the first day of the world indoor track and field championships in Belgrade, Serbia. Athlete Lemlem Hailu finished the women's 3000m with a composed performance crossing the line in 8:41.82, according to Athletics World. Lemlem sealed a memorable win – her first global medal as a senior athlete.

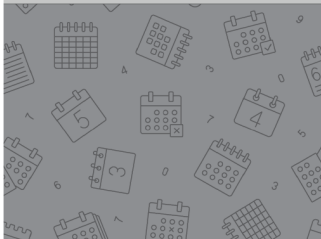

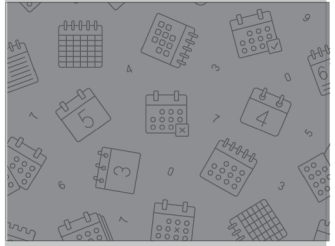

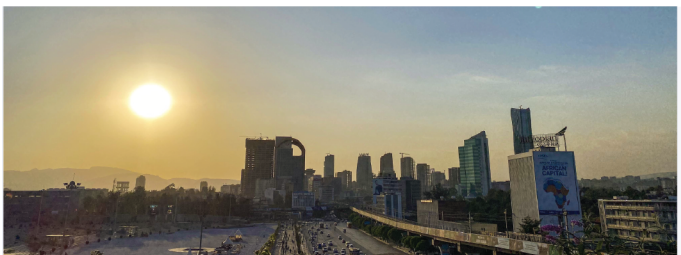

ETHIOPIAN TEACHER ASSEMBLES OWN DRONE.



Amanuel Balcha, a lecturer at the University of Dembi Dollo in Western Oromia, has successfully assembled “his own drone” and conducted a 250 meter long test-flight.

According to Dr. Leta Tesfaye, President of Dembi Dollo University, Emmanuel Balcha, a graduate of mechanical engineering from Arba Minch University, currently teaching at Dembi Dollo university, is also working on assembling two other drones and one aircraft using locally available parts.

The university celebrated the “Innovation Day” with panel discussions and exhibitions of innovative materials assembled by university students. Dr. Leta said the program was supporting university students in their creative endeavours and rewarding students who are exemplary in their creativity. The university is helping young innovators to develop and enrich other items such as coffee makers, wood scrubbers, textile machinery, different parts for various pieces of equipment, chicken incubator and water pumping motors among other items.

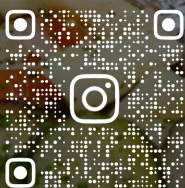



CAMEL LIBRARY.



The camel library initiative undergoes a digital revolution. In the Somali region of Ethiopia, Mahadiya, 14, spots something she has never seen before. She was expecting a crucial delivery of books to her remote community. What she saw was the peculiar sight of a solar powered camel. Over the last 20 years the Somali Region in Ethiopia has made significant improvements in its education system, leading to increased rates of primary school enrolments. However, the school system remains under resourced, with a severe shortage of teachers and books. The Camel Library initiative was born out of this need.

Save the Children and Library for All* have been helping rural Ethiopian villages access books through camels since 2010. Now, over a decade later, the four-legged libraries are getting a digital makeover. In September 2021 a pilot program was launched to revolutionise the Camel Library initiative. Instead of carrying up to 200 paper books, the camels carry a Library For All Spark Kit filled with tablet computers pre-loaded with hundreds of children's books ready to read. The tablets are charged by the sun via specially fitted solar panels. Everything is packed together on a camel-friendly harness uniquely developed for this project – showing there is no barrier to providing a quality education for children. Through the tablets from one of Library for All's Digital Camel Libraries, Mahadiya can access countless stories, including her own, Mahadiya and the Camel. "These days, I have become accustomed to reading books. For me, reading a book is the key to knowledge. I felt great joy and pride, when I was told that my and the camel library's story was chosen to prepare a children's book."

If this pilot program proves successful, we hope to roll out more Digital Camel Libraries in the future. This will help expand the selection of learning material for over 22,000 children across 33 villages that have been receiving books from the Camel Libraries since 2010.

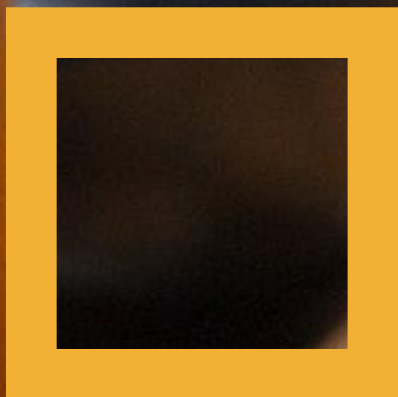

CRISPY STRIPS AND VEGGIES: CHICKEN.

SERVINGS: 4

INGREDIENTS

CRISPY CHICKEN STRIPS:

- 4 boneless, skinless chicken breasts
- 2 large eggs
- 3 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil, divided
- 1½ cups panko bread crumbs
- 2 teaspoons paprika
- 1½ teaspoons kosher salt, divided
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 2 cups broccoli florets
- ½ teaspoon ground black pepper, divided
- 2 cloves garlic, minced, divided
- 2 sweet potatoes, peeled

BBQ sauce, for serving (optional) Ketchup, for serving (optional)

PREPARATION:

1. Preheat the oven to 375°F (190°C) and line 2 baking sheets with parchment paper.
2. Slice the chicken breasts into strips.
3. In a medium bowl, add the eggs and 1 tablespoon of olive oil. Whisk to combine.
4. In a large bowl, combine the panko bread crumbs, paprika, and 1 teaspoon of salt.
5. Place the flour in another medium bowl.
6. Coat the chicken strips in the flour, then in the eggs, then in the bread crumbs and place on a baking sheet.

11

7. Cut the broccoli into florets.

8. In a large bowl, toss the broccoli florets with 1 tablespoon olive oil, ¼ teaspoon salt, ¼ teaspoon pepper, and half of the minced garlic. Arrange on half of the remaining baking sheet.

9. Cut the sweet potatoes in half lengthwise, then slice into half-moons.

10. Toss the sweet potatoes in a large bowl with the remaining tablespoon of olive oil, ¼ teaspoon salt, ¼ teaspoon pepper, and minced garlic, and place on the baking sheet next to the broccoli.

11. Bake both baking sheets simultaneously, until the veggies are browned and the chicken is crisp, about 20 minutes.

12. Make the dipping sauce: Combine the mayonnaise, mustard, and honey in a small bowl.

13. Serve the chicken and veggies with the dipping sauce, BBQ sauce, and ketchup, if using.

Note: Paprika gives the chicken tenders a golden color and subtle flavor, but feel free to omit it.

**Vegan/Vegetarian Substitution: Replace the breaded chicken strips with your favorite vegan protein or load up on veggies and roast a third vegetable in place of chicken.



THE POWERFUL LITTLE BOX.

The powerful little box (Automotive batteries) is designed to deliver maximum current for a short time. They are sometimes referred to as "SLI batteries", for starting, lighting and ignition.

Automotive battery keeps the electric current steady: also stabilizes the voltage in order to keep your engine running safe.

Car batteries vary in different types of specifications based on manufacturers and may display different symptoms that affects the weakness of your car battery. The major symptoms that will be caused due to weak or bad battery are as follows.

1.Slow engine crank: When you attempt to start the vehicle, the cranking of the engine is sluggish and takes longer than normal to start.

2.Check engine light: The check engine light sometimes appears when your battery power is weak. Strange system indicator lights appear –such as check engine and low coolant lights.

3.Slow Crank: You're starting your car, and it keeps turning and turning, eventually starting–or not.

4.Dim headlights: If car battery is failing, it's not going to be able to fully power your vehicle's electrical components – including your headlights will be dim and weak.

5.Backfiring: This is one warning sign you can't miss! A failing car battery can cause intermittent sparks. These sporadic sparks can lead to fuel accumulating in the cylinders when accumulated fuel is ignited.

6.Needing to press on the gas pedal to start: You shouldn't need to give your car gas to get it to start if you find that your car is only starting when you press your foot on the gas pedal.

If you have these kinds of car issues, please refer to your local mechanic and get the problem solved because your car battery is the source of your car!
