AbrehotEnlightenment) recently opened its doors to the public. The construction of the spacious and modern 19,000-square-meter facility took almost two years to construct and cost more than 1.1 billion birr. The 4-storey facility, the largest public library in the country, is equipped with 1.5km long shelves that can stock up to 1.4 million books. The library building also includes 8 bookstores, a delightful children's reading area and parking that can accommodate 115 vehicles at a time. In addition the library currently houses more than 300,000 local and 120,000 international research papers.





of the first off the beaten track
workshops I was excited to discover
after moving back here 10 years ago
was Entoto Beth Artisans – a small compound with
women from Entoto working on creating innovative
jewelry made from local recycled materials and scrap
metals including coffee beans and bullets excavated
from the Entoto Hills!

This business began with the inspiration and help of their NGO partner (Beza Entoto Outreach) and they still work closely with BCDA to transform the community on Entoto.

We have all seen the women backs arched carrying loads of branches down the Entoto Road. Most residents of Entoto have come to St. Mary's Church on the mountain seeking healing from their disease through a regime of fasting, praying and bathing in the holy water near the church. Or they come with afflicted family members. Many women have left their rural communities and family members for the chance to be healed or because they have been outcast by their families... and they find solace in the Entoto community with others who share the disease. However the chance for meaningful employment is slim and often the only resort for earning money is through begging or carrying back-breaking loads of firewood on their backs into the city for less than \$1.25 per load. This is where Entoto Beth Artisans comes to light and provides these women with viable and sustainable opportunities.



Bethlehem Berhane started Entoto Beth Artisans with the vision of empowering these women living with HIV so prevalent in the Entoto hills above Addis. She began providing counselling and once the women gained confidence she offered fair wage employment and technical training which enabled them to reintegrate into their communities and to become self-supporting earning a living to support themselves.

Nigist Haile, founder and executive director of CAWEE says: "Betty is focused, persistent, strong, assertive in achieving her dreams and stubborn when it comes to her visions. She also has endurance. She's not the kind of person who just gives orders. Her leadership style is service-oriented. She's a role model for her employees."

Artisan Tizita explains, "it is like being part of a family we are friends to each other. We are always discussing our social problems, we find a solution together. It is priceless when you compare it to my life alone years before."

Today the organisation employs over 200 employees and they offer much more than just coffee bean jewelry!

I'd like to talk about a friend and a co-worker of mine whose character, her keen interest and endeavor of portraying the Ethiopian Orthodox church and Ethiopia's history in general, by extracting and reflecting on a canvas what seems to be a thread at first glance, but upon closer inspection reveals its self to be a fabric, never fails to earn my admiration. For anyone who engages with her in a conversation having the proclivity to know about the history of her country, her deep knowledge and understanding which she reflects in her paintings from her perspective, helps that person gain a deep insight.

Having been born and raised in her country, Ethiopia, surrounded by its beautiful landscape, rich religious and cultural diversity and a proud regal past; combined with inspiration from great renaissance artists, she managed to capture the essence of her identity. One piece that evolved from such inspiration, was derived from the book of Enoch where she depicted Enoch contemplating, as he gazed towards several cliff-monasteries from a mountain.





The Ethiopian Art Conservation Program (EACP) is a bilateral project between Belgium and Ethiopia which has been in place since January of this year. In August 2021 it became an independent organization responsible for providing restoration and conservation education in Ethiopia. For both the structural build-up of the project and the implementation of the education, EACP calls on Ethiopian professionals.

In January 2020, conservator Naomi Meulemans (The Phoebus Foundation, Antwerp Belgium) set out to explore the cultural sector in Ethiopia; she went in search of her roots and history in the country she left as a child in 1990. Her goal was to bring together Western knowledge of art conservation with the substantive expertise and deontology of dealing with cultural heritage in Ethiopia.

Using our preserved heritage to look back can provide a new interpretation of both cultural issues and traceable evidence of our society's identity. It is precisely this search for identity that forms the founding principles of the Ethiopian Art Conservation Program. Not only does Ethiopia have an unparalleled wealth of historical sites that are part of humanity's anthropological history, but the overwhelming amount of on-going art and cultural experiences is impossible to map. Ethiopian art is inextricably linked to daily and ceremonial life. From childhood one comes into contact with centuries-old traditions which carry liturgical and philosophical



meanings. The traditions are recorded in everything, from art objects to utensils and in educational and decorative depictions. It stands above all else that Ethiopia is a crossroads of history, art and culture. There are a variety of projects including everything from excavation sites to well-organized conservation campaigns on historical Ethiopian artifacts inside the country as well as those located in institutions and museums worldwide. Not only have these projects increased the international knowledge of Ethiopian history, they have also stimulated tourist activities throughout the country. In fact, cultural tourism has grown to the point of becoming the number one source of income for local Ethiopian professionals.

While tourism brings with it a renewed vigilance, putting heritage front and center on the table, it is striking that there are no officially organized art conservation and deontology training programs for dealing with heritage within Ethiopia itself. Tourism and the cultural sector seem to be booming, but nurturing, preserving and restoring for the future seem to be largely a foreign affair. However, there is a great local concern for heritage conservation.

Jan 7, 2022 GENNA (CHRISTMAS) Year after year Christians recall the story of the Christ child in a manger, shepherds on Judean hills witnessing the celestial song of angels as they pronounced the Long Expected One had come.The Ethiopian Christmas (Genna or Ledet) falls on 7 January Christmas is celebrated after 43 days fasting known as Advent, with a spectacular procession, which begins at 6 a.m. and lasts until 9 a.m. After the mass service people go home to break the fast with the meat of chicken or lamb or beef accompanied with injera and the traditional drinks (i.e. tella or tej).

Wed, Jan 19, 2022 (TIMKAT (Amharic "baptism") (also spelled Timket, or Timqat) is the Ethiopian Orthodox celebration of Epiphany. It is celebrated on January 19 (or 20 on Leap Year), corresponding to the 10th day of Terr following the Ethiopian calendar. Timket celebrates the Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan River. This festival is best known for its ritual reenactment of baptism (similar to such reenactments performed by numerous Christian pilgrims to the Holy Land when they visit the Jordan)





THE FATHER OF ETHIOPIAN AIRLINES

Colonel John Charles Robinson was an American of African descent, a descendant of the enslaved Africans who were taken captive to America. He was recruited to defend Ethiopia against the invading forces of Benito Mussolini. He was not the only African descendant to support Ethiopia. Robinson was part of a generation that responded to the invitation before the war to help modernize Ethiopia. Benito Mussolini was an ally of Adolf Hitler and part of the international Axis Powers. Mussolini's motivation was to punish Ethiopians for their 1896 Adwa victory and to create a colony for Italy. Robinson's thoughts were to help keep Ethiopia forever free and to never become a colony as other African countries.

Born in Mississippi in 1903 Robinson graduated from the famous Tuskegee Institute in 1924. Robinson lived in a racially segregated America---a system of life like apartheid. He received his pilot's license under extreme odds in 1927. In 1930 the world witnessed the coronation of Haile Selassie as the new emperor of Ethiopia. This inspired millions of African descendants around the world for a new future for Africa. During the war years he flew reconnaissance, and was also the personal pilot to Emperor Haile Selassie. He

witnessed and reported the enemy's use of mustard gas and other atrocities. He served in the war in 1935 until 1944. Although leaving Ethiopia in 1936 he was part of public appearances to bring attention to the situation in Ethiopia which he felt was being ignored. He later returned to Ethiopia to train pilots for the new air force in 1946. Unfortunately, he died from injuries in a plane crash flying a medical mission in 1954. He is buried in the Catholic Cemetery in Gulele in Addis Ababa.

Honored in death in 2015 the U.S. Embassy in Ethiopia dedicated their reading garden to Colonel Robinson. As seen in Ghana in 2019, called the Year of Return, the new generation of African descendants are traveling to African countries not only for vacations and holidays, but education, investment and relocation. In their return they are seeking to recollect their heritage and roots through genealogy documents, DNA tests, film, oral histories and more. Robinson becomes of great interest to those traveling to Ethiopia and Africa in the 21st century, because in him they see an extraordinary African connection, and a shining example of bravery, heroism and Pan Africanism.

Preparation and cooking time

- Prep:15 mins
- Cook:45 mins
- Easy
- Serves 4

Slightly sweet with added richness from the coconut milk, this simple vegan curry is a winner. It's also freezable if you need a quick midweek fix

Ingredients

- 600g baby aubergines, sliced into rounds
- 3 tbsp olive oil
- 2 onions, finely sliced
- 2 garlic cloves, crushed
- 1 tsp garam masala
- 1 tsp turmeric
- 1 tsp ground coriander
- 400ml can chopped tomatoes
- 400ml can coconut milk
- pinch of sugar (optional)
- ½ small pack coriander, roughly chopped
- rice or chapatis, to serve



Method

- STEP 1

Heat oven to 200C/180C fan/gas 6. Toss the aubergines in a roasting tin with 2 tbsp olive oil, season well and spread out. Roast for 20 mins or until dark golden and soft.

- STEP 2

Heat the remaining oil in an ovenproof pan or flameproof casserole dish and cook the onions over a medium heat for 5-6 mins until softening. Stir in the garlic and spices, for a few mins until the spices release their aromas.

- STEP 3

Tip in the tomatoes, coconut milk and roasted aubergines, and bring to a gentle simmer. Simmer for 20-25 mins, removing the lid for the final 5 mins to thicken the sauce. Add a little seasoning if you like, and a pinch of sugar if it needs it. Stir through most of the coriander. Serve over rice or with chapatis, scattering with the remaining coriander.



THE ART OF SILVERS-MITHING

Ethiopia is known and appreciated the world over for its exquisite and intricate Crosses representing the centuries old Orthodox faith of the country going back to the preAxumite period. Crosses were first created out of wood, bone, leather and stone. The Falasha Jews, allegedly first practised the art and skill of producing crosses from silver. During the 19th century with the advent of silver coins, village artisans began to produce the traditionally worn cross in silver, beginning with simply carving a cross from the coin itself. However, in most cases the silver was melted down and a cross was then cast in wax thereby creating unique designs and styles. As the tradition evolved and expanded, many different cross designs began to be attributed to specific regions of Ethiopia. To this day certain styles are still identified with certain parts of the country with crosses from Axum, Lalibela, Gondar and Shewa remaining extremely popular. At the invitation of Menelik II, an Armenian goldsmith made the Imperial Crown and thereafter Armenians began introducing their own style and skill of craftsmanship in particular the delicate work of filigree.

Typically today to meet the continued demand for

Typically today to meet the continued demand for crosses, raw material is collected from different sources including used or damaged silver or old coins mostly from Yemen; sterling and fine silver sheet metal and bar stock (copper and brass included) are also used.

I was privileged to be invited to observe silversmithing in action in a Piassa workshop: After the melting of the raw material, the design is then drawn on paper and placed over the silver or metal and specific shapes are then cut accordingly. Hammers are also used to form the metal at room temperature; as the material is hammered, bent, and worked, it hardens. The design is "burned" into the silver or metal and then has to be smoothed repeatedly until it becomes very fine using hand tools for this detailed task. Once heated by charcoal, modern silversmiths commonly use gasburning torches as heat sources or even laser beam welding. Finally, once the design is set, the piece of jewelry must be cleaned in a solution of boiling water, lemon and salt several times. Next a hard brush and fine cloth are used for the drying and polishing processes until the finished product is smooth and gleaming and ready to be displayed! If you cannot afford silver or gold, then you can still opt for copper or brass or nickel which are individually crafted. Particular thanks go to designer/silversmith Mulugeta Behailu who allowed me into his Piassa workshop to observe and photograph artisans performing this delicate and intricate work. His shop specialising in beautiful silver items is located in Haya Hulet in front of St. Gabriel Hospital.

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
