



Nasra Mustofa Mohammed is a Fashion and Accessories

designer; she started her journey at Addis Ababa University studying Civil Engineering but then decided to join NEXT Fashion Institute, graduating with honors. Her family believed in her potential and started encouraging her to push further and with that momentum, she went on to join the Addis Ababa school of Fine Arts and Design, majoring in Fashion Design.

As a Muslim woman, Nasra grew up in a conservative community but she felt, that there could be a way in which clothing for Muslim women could still follow trends, whilst staying true to the Islamic culture. In this way, Nasra began to draw inspiration from Islamic patterns, which often lean towards geometric shapes and patterns. She also looked for inspiration from different cultures, both locally and abroad.


Her designs always begin with intensive research and seeking inspiration which leads to visual exploration in the form of sketches and finally on to execution, which involves material selection (mostly leather and different fabrics choosing what is most readily available locally), cutting of patterns and finalizing the product or clothing.

“Although I believe our fashion industry is growing, we as a society are yet to see the full potential of the industry. On the ground, we still see a lack of range of materials, raw materials, fabric choices, facilities for mass production, and the list can go on. As I



see it right now, the hustle for the shortcomings outweighs the hustle for the creative. We are often seen associating patterns and motifs as a sure sign of whether or not a design is African/Ethiopian, I believe that we should look deeper and see how that design was conceptualized and realized. I feel that if a project is conceptualized, designed and produced locally, it is an authentic African or Ethiopian design, regardless of the patterns and motifs associated and attached to that specific niche." MELAKU BELAY OF FENDIKA; TED FELLOW 2022.

Director of Fendika Cultural Center, Dancer and Choreographer Melaku Belay was selected as a TED Fellow, joining a class of 20 change-makers from around the world to deliver a talk on the TED stage this past April in Vancouver. Melaku was selected for his work that has brought global attention to the dynamic cultural development of Ethiopia, including music, dance, and visual art.

Melaku reflected on becoming the first TED Fellow out of Ethiopia: "I am very honored to be among this amazing class of TED Fellows. TED is a prestigious global forum; it means a lot that they recognize my work and understand my dream to show the richness of Ethiopian culture to the world. Through TED, I will learn from change-makers from around the world, build more bridges between peoples and cultures, and promote societal healing through arts and creativity."

Melaku's talk and performance received a standing ovation, and sparked many conversations about Ethiopian dance, arts, society, languages, and culture throughout the 4-day conference. Melaku's thoughts on TED: "I am proud to share my experience of Ethiopian culture and my work with Fendika Cultural Center. The world needs to hear from us, about Ethiopia's rich and diverse cultural heritage, about our creativity in music, dance, visual arts, and about how arts help us heal."



I felt comfortable and at home at the conference. The organizers and participants were energetic, friendly, and curious. I felt that I was embraced by a big family of visionaries. Besides the talks, there were many discovery sessions and workshops for people to learn from each other, to exchange ideas.”

As a dancer and choreographer, Melaku found it very encouraging that dance was an important part of this prestigious conference. He was among three choreographers who presented and performed in person. Here in Ethiopia, we need to recognize dance’s potential in helping us understand ourselves, connect to our history, and imagine our future. The government and private sector need to support and nurture dance, music and art in Ethiopia, because they are important for the peace and unity of our society.

About Fendika Cultural Center: Under Melaku’s leadership since 2008, Fendika Cultural Center is the first music venue in Addis Ababa that pays regular salary to traditional musicians and dancers. It is a home to artists of many disciplines and cultural backgrounds, offering a weekly multidisciplinary program including music, dance, visual art, and poetry.

SIRENS: DELIGHTFUL CHILDRENS BOOK PROMOTING ANIMAL WELFARE.

Sirens, a new children's book in English and Amharic, was published in October 2021 and is available in shops and crafts fairs around Addis. The story is about a little girl and her dog and is set in modern-day Addis Ababa. When a puppy is rescued from the streets of Addis Ababa, she thinks she has it made, but the security of her new world is threatened when her elderly neighbor falls ill and is taken to the hospital. Readers will get to know more about Ethiopian foods, language, and cultural values. The story also promotes kind treatment of animals.

Since publishing the book, Ms. Rae has visited several local schools to do readings with students from age two through nine. She enjoys talking to children about the book as well as how to treat animals humanely. Ms. Rae moved to Ethiopia in 2019 with her family. Her two children wanted to adopt a dog as soon as they arrived, so she made contact with Simona Grava, who runs the Addis Animal Project. Ms. Grava and other volunteers coordinate a network that finds animals forever homes. When Ms. Rae and her children met a small white and brown dog who had been rescued from the street, they fell in love.





They noticed that the dog had a funny habit of howling along with ambulances when they drove by. This habit of the dog's was the beginning of the story. As Covid worked its way through the city and the ambulances blaring their sirens multiplied, the scope of the book expanded. Ms. Rae explores themes of community, adoption, survival, and what it means to be a family in this story for children ages five to eight.

Another catalyst for the book was a series of paintings about street dogs at Tomoca in Serbet by local artist Lejkidus Bezzawork. Ms. Rae was taken with these paintings and would often visit the coffee shop to admire them. Through Instagram, she was made contact with the artist, who agreed to work on the project. His lively, endearing mixed-media illustrations make the urban zing of contemporary Addis life come alive.

Sirens is for children ages 4-10. In English and Amharic. Full-color illustrations by local artist Lejkidus Bezzawork. Translation by Alula Kibrom. 10% of the proceeds go to the Addis Animal Project.

ABOUT ETHIOPIAN TEA ■

Tea is grown year-round on both small- and large-scale gardens that are located in the forested highlands in the south and southwest regions, where the 2100-meter elevation is ideal. Around 7000 tons are produced annually, with over half of that consumed within the country. Nearly all the exported tea is black tea.

Tea plants were introduced into Ethiopia in 1927 due to its increasing popularity, although the industry has struggled over the years. Although more land was devoted to tea in 2020, production didn't keep up. Currently, tea leaves—two leaves and the bud—are hand plucked and put into bamboo baskets that the workers (primarily women) carry on their backs. For green tea, the leaves are simply dried; for black tea, they are first oxidized. All tea is supervised by the Ethiopian government and meets Global Good Agricultural Practices.

Although tea, is certainly grown in Ethiopia, “Ethiopian Tea” refers to the beverage that is enjoyed by consumers

in the country—and that means spiced tea. Whole or ground cardamom, cloves, cinnamon, ginger, and nutmeg are commonly listed with a sweetener optional. Unlike chai, however, milk is never added.

Recipe for Ethiopian Tea (Shai)

16 ounces of water
14 whole cloves
7 whole cardamom pods
2.5 inches of cinnamon stick
Bring to a boil in a pot on the stove.
Turn off the heat, and let the mixture sit for 6 minutes.

OR

1 teaspoon ground cardamom
1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
1/8 teaspoon ground nutmeg
1/8 teaspoon ground cloves
Ginger root (1 slice, 1/4-inch-thick)
1 cup water
Stir all ground spices together in a small bowl. Bring water to a boil. Add 1/8 teaspoon spice mixture and ginger and simmer 4 minutes.
Pour tea through a fine sieve lined with a coffee filter or paper towel in a cup.

GOOGLE TRANSLATE ADDS TWO ETHIOPIAN LANGUAGES.

Google has announced that Google Translate, its multilingual neural machine translation service, has begun offering the possibility of translation into 24 more languages. Ten of the new additions are African languages.

The Ethiopian language list includes Tigrinya, spoken by about 8 million people in Eritrea and Ethiopia and Oromo, spoken by 37 million people in Ethiopia and Kenya. The African languages of Bambara, Jeje, Krio, Luganda, and Tsonga were also added.

Google software engineer and researcher Isaac Caswell revealed that the company implemented, for the first time, the use of a neural model of artificial intelligence that learned the languages "from scratch." He explained

that to implement the new languages, Google used millions of examples that were needed for a system to "understand" and be able to translate them. With the neural model, also known as machine learning model, the added languages were trained in this way. Technology then began to "understand" how languages work. The company says it consulted representatives from several communities before releasing the new languages.

Along with the inclusion of the 10 African languages, the new language update Google Translator now offers a total of 133 languages. The tech giant has plans to soon add voice recognition.

From tech leaders, innovators, and investors to activists, Rest of World has identified 100 people outside Silicon Valley and the West whose efforts directly impact countries where the majority of the world's population lives. They set out to find 100 of the most influential, innovative, and trailblazing personalities in fintech, e-commerce, policy, digital infrastructure, and a range of other sectors that intersect with and influence technology for the inaugural RoW100: Global Tech's Changemakers.

To put together the list, their reporters and editors researched individuals in each regional ecosystem who have made an outsized contribution to their sectors while facing logistical, financial, and political challenges that come with building something ground breaking in those communities. They spoke to dozens of sources, many of them peers of the people on this list, to gauge the true impact of our nominees beyond the hype and the press release cycle.

Ethiopian Addis Alemayehou is included in this list. He is the founder and chairman of Kanzana Group,



a holding company with stakes in more than a dozen early stage companies across Africa, including mobile service provider Arada Mobile, streaming service Avetol, and Flex Towers, which delivers infrastructure for telecoms providers. He is one of the biggest cheerleaders for Ethiopia's nascent tech ecosystem. Alemayehou's entrepreneurial spirit was born in Canada, where he started buying and leasing properties when he was 18, after moving there to join his family. Ten years later, Alemayehou found his way back to Ethiopia, where he began working in the nonprofit sector and later broke into telecommunications.

All the individuals featured on the Global Tech's Changemakers list influence how products are made and distributed, how entrepreneurs are funded, and how tech is regulated and its users protected far beyond their local markets. As a result of the extraordinary headwinds they face, our editorial team believes these leaders are more innovative, more thoughtful, and better at sharing new ideas than most people in the Western world understand.
