KULUBI GABRIEL: ANNUAL CELEBRATION IN DECEMBER.

November marked the beginning of the advent or Christmas fast which runs from 24 November until Gena (Ethiopian Christmas) on 7 January, so it's a great time for vegans and vegetarians to enjoy the lovely fasting food at traditional restaurants, and the fried whole fish that is often served too.


The biggest annual Saints' Day in December is Saint Gabriel (28 December). On this day, you want to avoid the big St. Gabriel churches in Addis unless you want to attend the service as roads are crowded and many closed. The roads going up to the palace above the Hilton are always blocked off as thousands head to St. Gabriel's church.

The archangel Gabriel is one of the most revered saints in the Ethiopian Orthodox Tewahedo Church. However, the epicenter of this festival is a major pilgrimage to Kulubi, a town not far from Dire Dawa and Harar. Here tens of thousands of pilgrims descend on the church (built in 1880) some crawling on hands and knees as a penance or to fulfil a vow to St. Gabriel.

Orthodox Tewahedo (one in union) Christians mark the celebration with colorful processions and ceremonies. Kulubi is the largest pilgrimage place in Ethiopia. Babies born through St. Gabriel's intervention are brought to the front of the Church for baptism. During the duration of the celebration about 1,000 babies may be christened, most of them named after St. Gabriel.

PROFESSOR GEBISA EJETA AWARDED U.S.A. NATIONAL MEDAL OF SCIENCE

President Joe Biden awarded the National Medal of Science to Gebisa Ejeta, a Purdue University professor who developed sorghum hybrids that have helped feed millions of people in sub-Saharan Africa.

Professor Gebisa is a Distinguished Professor of Plant Breeding and Genetics, and International Agriculture, Executive Director of the Purdue Center for Global Food Security and Purdue University Presidential Fellow for Food Security and Sustainable Global Development.

He received the 2009 World Food Prize for his research on sorghum, an ancient grain that is a staple food for millions of people in Africa and Asia.

His work has helped to create sorghum hybrids that are resistant to both severe drought and the destructive parasitic Striga weed. These hybrids have helped to increase sorghum production in sub-Saharan Africa by up to 50%, which has helped to reduce hunger and poverty in the region.

Professor Gebisa Ejeta was born and raised in Ethiopia and earned his bachelor's degree from Haramaya University. He received his master's and PhD degrees in plant breeding and genetics from Purdue, where he has been a faculty member since 1984.

In addition to his scientific achievements, Professor Gebisa is also a passionate advocate for agricultural development and food security in Africa. He has served on numerous boards and commissions, including the African Union's High-Level Panel on Food Security and Nutrition.

ANTIQUARIAN BOOKS AND LOCAL HISTORY IN PIASSA

Piassa is filled with history from its significant architectural history to the locals who have been born and raised there. Strolling through Piassa, it is possible to savour the sense of community and history of this unique area of Old Addis, where many Ethiopians from diverse backgrounds have grown up.

Abdi Negash, owner of a small antiquarian emporium, is Piassa born and bred. He acquired an interest in antiquarian books and artifacts after working in the old Italian book shop "Libereria Italiana" in Piassa (on the same block as Enrico Pastry shop) where he also learned to speak Italian fluently.

Once the bookshop closed, Abdi inherited much of the classic collection and began to seek out other such treasures from individuals and families.

Abdi's small emporium (you must make an appointment for a visit) in Piassa is an incredible treasure trove of books, artwork, records and various old artifacts. All crammed together surrounding his desk, there is literally barely room to move but Abdi knows where to find anything and everything!

In addition to selling these items, Abdi also provides informal tours around Piazza. Part of the enjoyment of these tours is the obvious love he has for his community (lots of stops en route to greet friends and neighbors).

He knows all about the families who lived in some of the once great houses or villas both past and present, which truly brings the history of Piassa to life. You are not just looking at four walls within a compound; you are learning about the inhabitants and appreciating the current residents, from a true local historian! Please note that appointments in advance are essential.

DEFO DABO

Defo Dabo is a traditional Ethiopian bread that holds deep cultural significance, particularly during festive occasions. It is made using Enset plant leaves, locally known as Koba Kitel, which infuse the bread with a distinctive flavor. This bread serves as a symbol of unity, bringing families and communities together in the joy of communal meals.

The process of making Defo Dabo involves a shared effort, often involving multiple generations, reinforcing the importance of tradition and connection. From the earthy aroma to the unique taste, this bread represents the rich cultural heritage of Ethiopia and the traditions that bind its people together.

Ingredients

- 3 ¼ cups wheat flour
- 12 oz warm water
- ½ a packet of instant yeast
- ½ lb Enset leaves
- 3 tbsp sugar
- ½ tbsp salt
- ½ tbsp coriander powder
- ½ tbsp cumin
- ½ tbsp cardamom
- 2 tbsp olive oil

METHOD

1. Start by adding the instant yeast, sugar, and salt into a mid-sized bowl. Then pour the 12 oz. water into the mix and stir it thoroughly.
2. Cover the mixture and let it sit for about 20 min. to get the yeast activated and start to bubble.
3. Mix the coriander powder, cumin, and cardamom with oil and pour in the flour. Then use your hands to mix and knead them until the dough is soft, moist, and elastic. Add some more water if necessary.
4. Set the dough aside and let it sit for some 60 minutes – covered with a clean cloth or plastic. By the end, the dough should rise to about double its original size.
5. Place the dough in a large-sized baking pan that has been lined with some Enset leaves and aluminum foil both on the sides and the base. Then place some more Enset leaves on top of the dough.
6. Let the dough sit for about 20 minutes while it's still covered in Enset leaves, then transfer it to an oven that has been preheated to 350°.
7. Bake the dough until the dough is cooked thoroughly for about 50 – 60 minutes, and remove it from the oven. Peel off the Enset leaves and slice pieces to serve.

KATIM DISABILITY AWARENESS & SUPPORT (KDAS)

A group of well-trained dancers and performers with disabilities believe there are options beyond handicrafts

In 2020, a few well-trained and experienced Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) founded Katim Disability Awareness & Support (KDAS) as a non-profit organization to tackle the challenges persons with disabilities face.

By using art and sport as tools to break down barriers, misperceptions and stereotypes, KDAS aims to raise awareness towards disability to create an inclusive society where PwDs can exploit their hidden talents and creativity.

A group of well-trained dancers and performers with disabilities believe there are options beyond handicrafts and that PwDs want to be able to provide for their families and contribute to society. They particularly encourage PwDs to realize their potential and capabilities through dance and performance art.

As well as delivering traditional and contemporary dance workshops for PwDs, KDAS also delivers Ethiopian traditional dance workshops for foreign nationals.

The other significant engagement of KDAS is to enhance the physical and mental capacity of students with disabilities through the provision of specialized physical exercise, counseling and dance therapy thus boosting the psychological, physical and social abilities of youths with disabilities who attend primary school. The sessions are run by persons with disabilities themselves.

KDAS also gives performances, such as Enchilalen 1 and Enchilalen 2 ("we can"), as entertainment and educational projects that are used as advocacy pieces to increase acceptance and the embracing of inclusion with full participation of PwDs in the community. The Enchilalen 2 performance incorporated a Disability Fashion Show, Disability Contemporary Dance Performances, and the artistic works of prominent artists with disabilities.

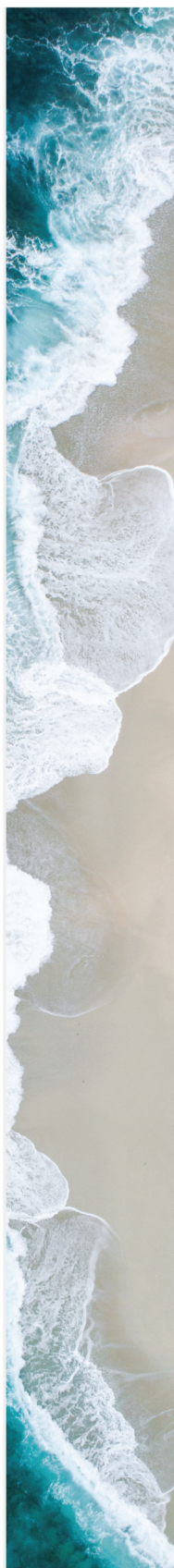
