Welcome to Mamma Mia, an authentic Italian restaurant specializing in traditional, homemade dishes with a choice of ten different kinds of freshly made pasta. Since it opened in 2015, Mamma Mia has become popular for relaxed lunches and intimate dinners as well as a venue for special occasions such as birthdays and weddings.

It has also gained a reputation as something of a diplomatic hub, becoming a firm favorite with many in the international community and has often hosted high-level visiting delegations.

The restaurant is personally run by the owners: Bruno, who enthusiastically welcomes diners with detailed explanations of the menu choices and his wife, Jitu Daba Erensa, the talented chef who trained in Italy and had her own Italian restaurant in Italy before moving back to Ethiopia in 2014.

During the recent Dashen Culture Club Pasta Festa held in Addis Ababa in November at the Millennium compound, Chef Jitu entered the Cooking Competition, which she won with her signature dish of Artichoke Ravioli in Butter, Parmesan Cheese and Thyme.

NU CHIKA ENABUKA: EMBRACING ETHIOPIAN CULTURE FOR CHILDREN

The Nu Chika Enabuka Family Center is a children's play area with adult supervision that provides a variety of parent-child activities focused on the physical, emotional, and social growth of kids.

A sizable, full-scale play structure is available for the children, while a smaller one is available for toddlers. In addition, the Center sells unique toys and other goods and has a café which serves consumers with nutritious snacks, drinks, and desserts.

The facilities are created to keep kids active, amused and stimulated, while fostering strong cultural and social skills. The central idea of Nu Chika Enabuka, is the restoration of Ethiopian identity from the beginning. The goal is to help kids stay rooted in Ethiopian cultural traditions and customs by creating an opportunity for them to play with their families, learn through fun, educational games and skills while learning about their culture.

Established in 2019 and located in the 22 Mazoriya area, Nu Chika Enabuka Family Center transmits indigenous knowledge to children in an organized manner and entertains the family together.

The Center has also produced a children's television program called Hamrawi, which airs on Ethiopian Children's Television and YouTube





channels and which focuses on creativity, art and recycling.

The organization has also expanded its horizons to introduce Ethiopian childhood to the world by globalizing Ethiopian Childhood and introducing Nu Chika Enabuka to Ethiopians abroad.

The founders, married couple Hamere Mulugeta and Yoseph Weldeamanuel, are Ethiopian artists who are committed to the restoration and education of Ethiopian cultural identity.

PRECIOUS AND HISTORICAL ARTEFACTS RETURNED TO ETHIOPIA

Recently, precious Ethiopian artefacts that had been looted were returned to Ethiopia's UK Ambassador Teferi Melesse Desta at a reception organised by the private, non-profit Scheherazade Foundation in London.

All the artefacts were gifted or secured by private benefactors and included a sacred Tabot, believed to have been looted at Maqdala in 1868, as well as a lock of hair from Prince Alemayu, son of the Abyssinian Emperor Tewodros II.

Dr Jacopo Gnisci, a scholar in Ethiopian studies, had sufficient knowledge to source and return the Tabot to the Ethiopian Orthodox Church. The Tabot itself, described as a square wooden tablet with inscriptions and artworks, was handed over to a delegation of clergy.

Another highly symbolic repatriation involved a lock of hair removed from Prince Alemayu by his one-time guardian Captain Tristram Speedy. Four descendants of Capt. Speedy travelled from New Zealand to arrange the transfer. "It felt like Prince Alemayu's lock of hair was a long way from home," said Leonie Turner speaking of their precious family heirloom. Other items returned at the event included a silver-mounted horn cup bearing the inscription "Taken at Magdala". Its owners said it was the right time to pass its guardianship back to Ethiopia.

Another returning horn cup had been identified and purchased by Tahir Shah, founder and CEO of the Scheherazade Foundation, at an auction in Canterbury last April. The ceremonial shield gifted by a European collector was once in the possession of a gentleman whose ancestor probably served at Maqdala. "These are not merely objects," said Ambassador Teferi Melesse. "They are the embodiment of our Church, our culture and our history." Professor Alula Pankhurst, a member of Ethiopia's National Heritage Restitution Committee, said that conditions for repatriation of artifacts should be strengthened.

His latest gastronomic venture, Marcus Addis is a new restaurant featuring a fusion of international cuisine with an Ethiopian twist. This restaurant is a partnership between Albwardy Hospitality, with Hyatt as the operator, and world-renowned Ethiopian born chef and author Marcus Samuelsson.

Marcus Addis is located on the 47th floor of the new Commercial Bank of Ethiopia building, the tallest building in East Africa standing at 209 meters. The interior of the new restaurant is a modern masterpiece that expertly incorporates

FRIENDSHIP PARK – AN OASIS IN THE HEART OF ADDIS



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Friendship Park is the largest urban park in Addis Ababa across the street from Unity Park. Entrance, by car or foot, is across the road from the entrance of the Sheraton Hotel.

It was opened on 10 September 2020. Friendship Park, sometimes referred to as Friendship Square, has a paved track alongside steps with attractive flower beds up the slope. There is an outdoor amphitheater with a stage over an artificial lake. On the other side of the lake is the riverside walkway which will be part of the 56 km green road that will extend from Mount Entoto to Akaki.

The park contains eateries, greenhouses, a fitness center and a running track. Currently, it costs 130 ETB to enter for as long as you like and there is a large car park.

The park has an artificial lake, with a water fountain that is illuminated at night. It also contains a variety of flowers and a diverse species of flora. The diversity of the Ethiopian people is illustrated by the planting of 80 trees on two walkways.

Friendship Park is the pilot project of Beautifying Sheger, aka Addis Ababa Riverside Green Development Project, funded by the Chinese. Beautifying Sheger is an initiative of the current government. It is an ambitious project which will ultimately utilize four tributaries of the Akaki River (Kebena, Kurtume, Kechene, and Banti-eyikitu) for creating green spaces including a 56 km walkway from Mount Entoto to Akaki.

The project will protect the rivers from pollution, reduce flooding, and contribute to Addis becoming bike-friendly and to attract tourists. The development and ongoing management overall has created numerous job opportunities.

It is a delightful green space enjoyed by families, couples and visitors – well worth a visit.

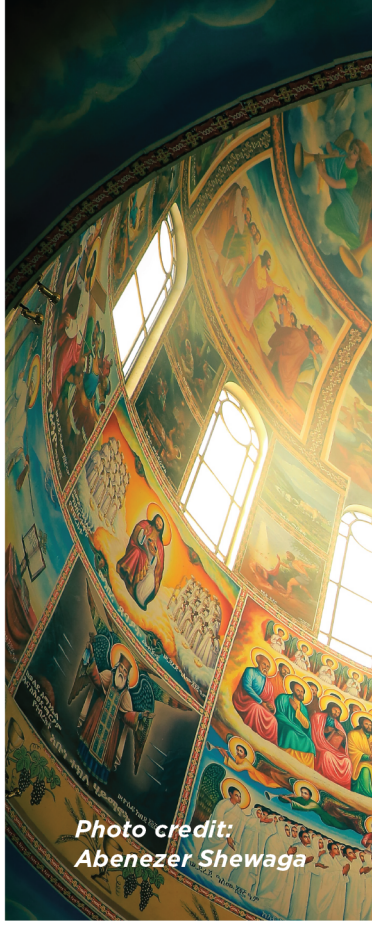

GARLIC BREAD

Toasty, buttery, herby, covered in a dusting of salty parmesan cheese, piping hot and fresh out of the oven—our homemade garlic bread recipe is everything you're craving right now, and then some.

INGREDIENTS

- 1 cup unsalted butter, softened (8oz/240gm)
- 1/4 cup minced fresh parsley
- 6 garlic cloves, minced
- 1 tsp garlic powder
- 1/2 tsp sea salt (only 1/4 tsp if using salted butter)
- 3/4 cup grated parmesan cheese
- 1 (1 lb) rustic loaf of bread, baguette or ciabatta

METHOD

1. In a medium sized bowl, mix together the butter, parsley, garlic, garlic powder, salt and half of the grated parmesan cheese until fully combined.
2. Slice the loaf of bread in half lengthwise, being careful to keep the thickness the same on both sides.
3. Turn the oven to HIGH.
4. Using a knife or spatula, spread half of the garlic butter mixture onto one half of the loaf. Repeat with remaining butter on the second half. Set the bread buttered side up on a rimmed baking sheet and sprinkle with the remaining Parmesan cheese.
5. Place the baking sheet in the oven on the center rack and broil/grill until golden brown, about 3-4 minutes. Watch carefully so that the bread doesn't burn.
6. Remove the bread from the oven and garnish with a little extra parsley for color. Serve immediately.



TIMKET

As the dawn of Timket approaches, Ethiopia becomes a vibrant hub of celebratory activity as the Ethiopian Orthodox church meticulously stages an opulent re-enactment of Jesus Christ's baptism in the River Jordan by the revered figure of John the Baptist. A multitude of colorful ceremonies are dispersed across the country, firmly cementing this grand religious festival as a paramount occasion in the Ethiopian calendar.

At twilight, devout priests in various churches tenderly clothe their sacred Tabots, which symbolize the revered Ark of the Covenant, in lavish garments. This sacred ritual, steeped in profound reverence, remains hidden from the public eye. Subsequently, a jubilant procession ensues as the priests accompany the Tabot to a nearby stream or pool, where it finds a serene dwelling within an embellished tent. This tranquil abode is filled with hymns and collective prayers from the congregation.

As the following day dawns, the priests sanctify the adjacent water, bestowing upon it a sacred aura, and proceed to sprinkle the crowd with its blessed droplets. Some individuals eagerly immerse themselves in the water, symbolizing their reaffirmation of baptismal vows.

The Tabot, embraced by a vibrant procession akin to its initial journey, is then escorted back to its rightful place of worship. Once the holy Tabot is safely returned to its sacred abode, a joyous crowd disperses to their homes, each filled with an animated spirit, ready to partake in a festive feast that amplifies the importance of this extraordinary event.

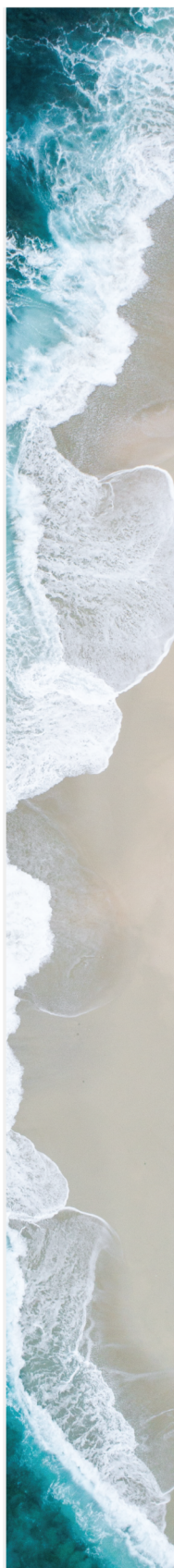
