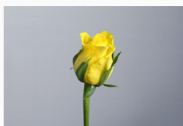

**S**ince its creation in 2007, Liya Kebede's brand Lemlem has aimed to preserve traditional Ethiopian weaving techniques while providing stable jobs for women.

Lemlem is contributing to Ethiopia's economic growth, which has averaged 10% annually, by focusing on slow, ancestral techniques. Every Lemlem garment is handmade by Ethiopian artisans, who have inherited these skills through generations.

By upholding the ancient Ethiopian clothing process, Lemlem not only preserves cultural heritage but also ensures fair wages for these women. In addition to generating employment opportunities, Lemlem actively gives back to Ethiopian and Kenyan communities through the Lemlem Foundation.

With each purchase, 5% of the proceeds go towards training artisans and supporting AMREF African Health (AMREF: the African Medical and Research Foundation). AMREF believes that the power to transform Africa's health lies within its communities, and therefore, strives to ensure that health systems are not only functional but that communities are empowered to hold these systems accountable for the delivery of quality and affordable health care.

AMREF has been active in Ethiopia since the 1960s, working through their European and North American network of sister organizations on program implementation, advocacy, fundraising and partnerships. AMREF subsidiaries include AMREF Flying Doctors, AMREF Enterprises Limited and the AMREF International University.

Liya emphasizes that Lemlem's mission goes beyond creating a brand; it is about changing lives and making a positive impact on entire communities.

# HUMAN CENTRIC DESIGN.

**H**ave you ever walked into an apartment building and thought, 'Gosh, this hallway is narrow', or "Oh, this room is small"?

In previous years, the focal point of design was to capture the highest return on investment, meaning that Traditional Corporate Real Estate (CRE) prioritized building occupancy and utilization to ensure every square foot was used efficiently.

While those measurements still have value, they don't reveal how people feel about the space. When the focus of design is purely investment, we end up with spaces that cause the end users to be unhappy and unhealthy.

Given that we spend more than 75% of our time indoors it is important to remember the importance of creating spaces that are happy, healthy, relaxing, engaging, and empowering.

Nebat Apartments is one of the few apartment buildings found in Addis Ababa whose design focus was predominantly on the end users. Co-designed by Mugo Design and Geretta Consult Plc, the design captures luxury living gracefully. It provides expansive common corridors, large foyers for each unit and spacious sized bedrooms.

Difficult as it may be, finding the balance between human-centric design and the return on investment guarantees a successful real estate project.

Are there any other apartment buildings you can think of that are human-centric in their designs?

# KUBIK: HOMES FROM RECYCLED PLASTIC WASTE

The amount of plastic waste produced globally is on track to triple to over 1,000 million tons by 2060. The Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) report predicts that developed countries will continue to produce the most plastic waste per person, although emerging regions like Africa and Asia are expected to experience the fastest growth owing to rapid population growth and urbanization.

Plastic pollution is already a menace, said to be altering environments and endangering lives, but there is a glimmer of hope as the share of recycled plastic is expected to nearly double over the same period to 17% as plastic going through waste management systems increases.

Kidus Asfaw is Co-founder & CEO of Kubik, an environmental tech company that converts hard-to-recycle plastic waste into low-carbon, low-cost buildings.

Kubik's mission is to build dignity through clean and affordable living for all - a vision that gave Kidus the honour of being named one of TIME's 100 Most Influential Climate Leaders.

By 2030, 300 million families will need a dignified place to live in. The team at Kubik are doing something about it.

This upcycling start-up has operations in Kenya and Ethiopia and is among companies that are leading plastic waste reuse and sustainability efforts in the continent's nascent recycling sector, which currently salvages only 4% of the waste produced. The start-up turns hard-to-recycle plastic waste (polyethylene, polypropylene, and polystyrene) into affordable building materials, removing 45,000 kg of plastic waste from landfills every day.

# RIBBON

## CAULIFLOWER FRITTERS

“These cauliflower fritters are easy to make and a different way to have cauliflower. They are so delicious and tasty. I’ve made them a number of times for my family and friends.” BETTYCOOK

Prep Time: 10 mins  
 Cook Time: 10 mins  
 Total Time: 20 mins  
 Servings: 6

### INGREDIENTS

- 6 cups cauliflower florets
- ½ cup all-purpose flour
- 3 extra large eggs
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 (.7 ounce) package dry Italian-style salad dressing mix
- ½ cup olive oil for frying, or as needed

### DIRECTIONS

1. Process cauliflower in a food processor, finely minced; transfer to a large bowl.
2. Stir flour, eggs, baking powder, and Italian dressing mix into cauliflower.
3. Heat enough olive oil to cover the bottom of a frying pan over medium heat.
4. Drop heaped tablespoons of the cauliflower mixture into the hot oil; fry until golden brown, about 3 minutes per side.

### RECIPE TIP

Instead of 6 cups of cauliflower, you can use 3 cups of cauliflower and 3 cups of broccoli.

# EXQUISITE ETHIOPIAN BASKET CHANDELIER AT SKYLIGHT HOTEL

In November 2022, the China National Aero-Technology International Engineering Corporation approached Salem's Designs with a unique basket design to be transformed into a giant chandelier and mounted from a ceiling.

This was an almost impossible task since their artisans had never attempted such a project. However, they thought that it would be the ideal opportunity to test the capabilities of the artisans and so accepted the work order in January 2023.

Salem asked for a metal frame with the desired shape to be provided, with the rest of the intricate weaving of the design to be undertaken by the artisans.

It took 7 women roughly 700 hours and 3½ months to complete the task. The actual physical difficulty and back breaking nature of the work necessitated the women to work in morning and afternoon shifts.

The basketry section at Salem's has been a popular and enduring feature since 2008 with skills often passed down within families. However, with regard to design, quality and overall marketability, the women artisans' skills have been enhanced over the years through training and guidance. While some of the Salem's Design artisans work from home, the women who worked on this project are all salaried and long-time employees.

Although a Chinese organisation commissioned this work and it hangs in a Chinese built hotel, you might well assume that it is a Chinese made basket! However, it is proudly Ethiopian –in design and hand weaving, produced by dedicated and skilled Ethiopian artisans!

If you haven't visited Salem's Designs yet, a cultural emporium of beautiful Ethiopian fashions, jewellery, accessories and of course basketry awaits you!

# THE ADWA ZERO KILOMETER PROJECT NEARING COMPLETION.

The Adwa Zero Kilometer Museum Project is underway in the historic Piassa across from the office of the mayor and next to the statue of Emperor Menelik II.

This project celebrates Ethiopia commemorating its victory at the Battle of Adwa against Mussolini's Italy. The victory of Adwa is a source of pride for Ethiopians and the Adwa Zero Kilometres Project is where Ethiopians will be able to come to celebrate the victory of their forefathers.

The Adwa Project will consist of a museum, a meeting hall (for more than 2000 people,) three smaller auditoriums with capacity for 400 and parking for 600 cars, a cinema, library, gym, cafeterias and a childcare centre, among other leisure facilities.

As a memorial centre of the African Battle of Adwa Victory, the Adwa Centre is expected to serve as a platform for a reinvigoration of the spirit of Pan-Africanism. Contained within the museum there will be historical artefacts, documents, photographs as well as multimedia presentations including immersive exhibits that will enable visitors to be transported back to the time of Emperor Menelik II and Empress Taitu, alongside the esteemed cabinet of the period.

With construction nearing its final stages, the Chinese Jiangsu firm, awarded the 4.6 billion birr bid, is poised to deliver the long-awaited Museum. It is expected to open in the early part of 2024.

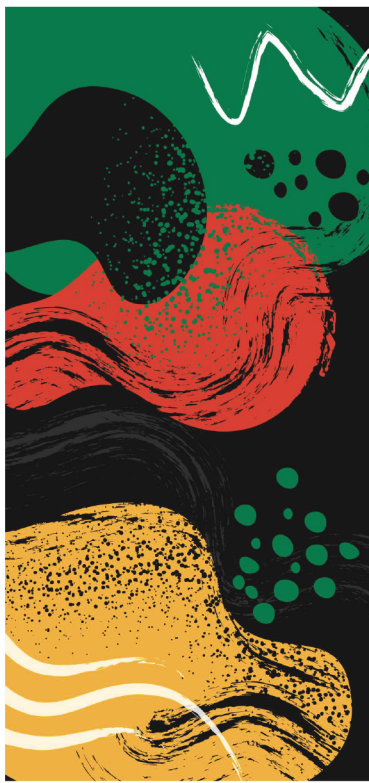

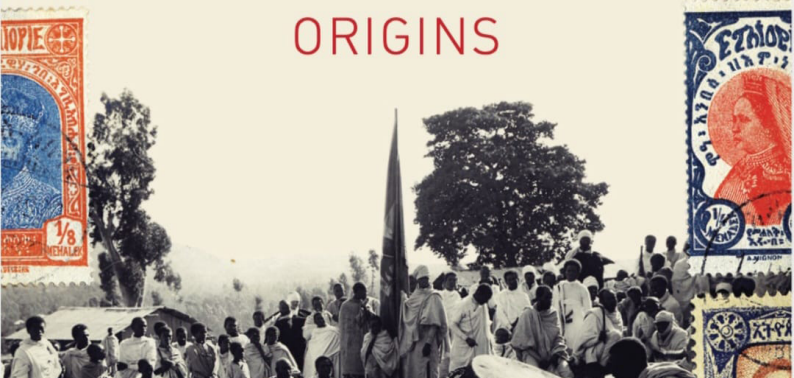

# FANTASTIC FLAX KNOWN LOCALLY AS TALBA

The actual flax seed is tiny but it is mighty. Not many people are aware of the fact that this little seed is packed full of nutrients. It is high in essential B vitamins and magnesium but also rich in omega 3 and contains fiber and vital antioxidants.

Flax seeds need to be ground into a fine powder or meal in order to release all these nutrients, and the recommended daily dose is about 2-3 tablespoonfuls. Too much flax can create the adverse effect of a laxative!

The nutrients of flax seeds are at their optimum when ground and consumed fresh – they can be retained in the seed until ready for consumption for up to a year – provided that they have not been exposed to heat.

Once ground (and stored away from heat and light), flax/talba will remain fresh for a few months and should preferably be refrigerated (the oil in the seeds, as with nuts, has a tendency to become rancid if left longer). Flax is said to have originated from Egypt as an herb. Ancient Egyptians reputedly used it for nutritional and medicinal purposes.

The gummy substance of flaxseed meal (once it is mixed with a little water) can actually be used as an egg replacement during fasting season to bind ingredients together.

Here are some suggestions on how to use flaxseed meal, which has a pleasant nutty flavor, and can provide these dishes with a boost of added nutrition:

- Sprinkle on hot or cold cereal
- Blend into juice, smoothies or soups
- Sprinkle on salads or cooked vegetables
- Add to meatballs or meatloaf
- Sprinkle on yogurt
- Mix into casseroles and baked goods (muffins, cookies or breads).

# ETHIOPIAN TEENAGER WINNER OF PRESTIGIOUS 2023 YOUNG SCIENTIST CHALLENGE

*14-year-old Ethiopian American, Heman Bekele wins the 2023 3M Young Scientist Challenge with Skin Cancer Treating Soap.*

Heman spent the last four months competing against nine other finalists and secured his win during final Challenge events at 3M global headquarters in St. Paul, MN, USA on 9 and 10 October 2023. Finalists navigated a series of interactive challenges and were evaluated on their ingenuity and innovative thinking, application of STEM principles, demonstration of passion and research, presentation skills, and ability to inspire others.

Heman developed Melanoma Treating Soap (MTS), a compound-based bar of soap designed as a skin cancer-treating soap, or SCTS for short. The soap replenishes the skin with dendritic cells, which help protect the skin and fight cancer. Heman said that after getting a prescription, the soap can be applied to the skin every couple of days and then one will start to see progress.

Heman received 25 thousand US dollars for winning the competition and was also given the title of 'America's Top Young Scientist'. The Ethiopian-born teenager will have the prospect of multilateral support for his scientific research endeavors in the future.

Speaking about his vision in the future, the teenager revealed that he envisions himself leading a team of professionals in the development of innovative electrical systems that will shape the future of technology. "Alongside my professional success, I hope to have a fulfilling personal life with a loving family and a strong network of friends. I also hope to have given back to my community by mentoring aspiring engineers and supporting initiatives that promote STEM education," Heman reckoned. Ultimately, in 15 years, Heman said he hopes to have made a positive impact on the world through his work and personal endeavors.

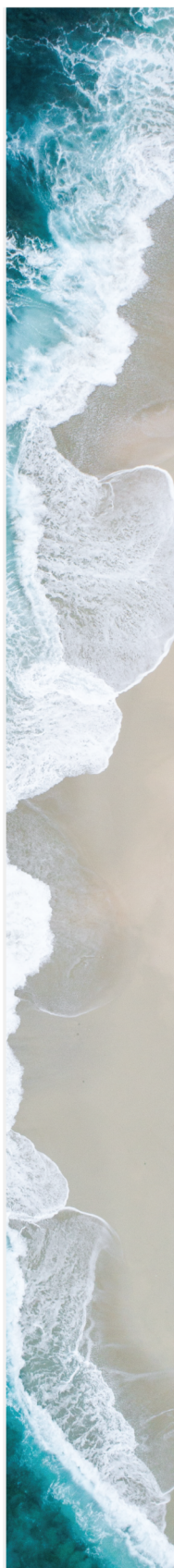
