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THE ENDURING POWER OF ART: ISRAEL WOLDEMICHAEL

During April 2025, art enthusiasts and artists in Ethiopia enjoyed two amazing opportunities to connect at the renowned Art of Ethiopia exhibition at Sheraton Addis and at the Big Art Sale fair at Hilton Addis Ababa.

The Big Art Sale was celebrating 20 years of providing a platform for local artists to promote their work while fostering support for the artistic community.

One of the artists that eagerly anticipated the Big Art Sale was Israel Woldemichael, a seasoned artist whose works reflect deep emotion, spirituality, and social commentary.





His story of hardship is one many artists face. As a young man, Israel lived in exile, first in Djibouti and then in Kenya, where he spent several years. These formative experiences shaped his worldview and later became a subtle thread running through his art. His paintings often explore themes of resilience, identity, and the complexities of modern life.

Between 2008 and 2012, he exhibited his works in multiple exhibitions, gaining recognition for his emotional depth and unique artistic voice. His art is characterized by symbolic forms, and powerful color palettes that invite the viewer into a space of reflection.

Israel's work doesn't just express individual experience—it resonates with broader social realities, capturing the tension between hardship and hope. He has also collaborated with fellow artists, enriching the local art scene through shared exhibitions and creative partnerships.

Although he currently faces a sudden disability, Israel continues to paint. His dedication to his craft remains strong, and his art now carries an even deeper sense of personal struggle and triumph, reflecting the enduring power of art to reflect the soul and heal the spirit.

BABILE CAMEL MARKET



Camels, dubbed the ships of the desert, are integral to the life of pastoralists living in lowland areas of Ethiopia, citing their crucial use for transport. Their natural ability to withstand the scorching hot temperatures and to survive without water for weeks in such areas makes them popular domestic animals. Also, camels are a favorite source of milk and meat among these pastoralist communities, and are also exported to Arab countries as far as the UAE and Saudi Arabia.

The Babile area, some 540 km east of Addis in the Somali Region, is famous for its weekly Camel Market.

Every Monday, hundreds of camel owners bring



their best bred camels to a huge open field in the heart of Babile town, numbering from three to five thousand camels for sale.

The market is filled with a lively atmosphere, full of women wearing colorful "shiti" dresses and hijabs, old women decorated with henna and most of all, camels of different sizes and ages crowding the open field.

The market itself is a sight to behold but there is another unique feature that one experiences in Babile. To avoid brokers involving with potential buyers and inflating the price, deals are made in a discreet manner. Once a buyer approaches the owner and selects the camel of his choice, the price will not be discussed orally. Rather, they hide themselves in a scarf or behind the camels and use the creases on their fingers to negotiate the price.

A good camel could cost up to 200,000 birr or more and once they agree on the price, the deal is sealed with a handshake. Sometimes transactions are made hours or days after the deal.

A visit to the Babile Camel Market can be combined with a safari in Babile Elephant Sanctuary, home to the largest population of African Bush Elephants in Ethiopia, and a visit to the historic town of Harar, just 30km outside Babile Town.

ET 302 MEMORIAL MONUMENT & PARK: HEALING THROUGH ARCHITECTURE

'On March 10, 2019, Ethiopian Airlines Flight 302 claimed 157 lives, leaving grieving families who gathered to honor their loved ones. In December 2019, a ten-member family committee was established to work with Boeing, Ethiopian Airlines, and other stakeholders to ensure a respectful design. In February 2022, after an international design competition, Alebel Desta Consulting Architects and Engineers were selected for their concept focused on absence, revelation, and healing.

The memorial was inaugurated on March 10, 2025, the sixth anniversary of the crash, with nearly 1,200 attendees. Speeches by family representatives, Alebel Desta, Ethiopian Airlines' CEO Mesfin Tasew, and government officials marked the ceremony, as families laid flowers by the burial ground and unveiled plaques bearing victims' names.

The memorial park centers on two sacred sites: the Crash Site and the Burial Ground. A main trail retraces the final moments of the flight, leading to a sculptural monument formed by four inclined, earth-red pigmented concrete forms representing Africa, Europe, North America, and Asia. Plaques resembling Boeing 737 MAX 8 windows display names, birth years, and nationalities. Each inclined form leads to a raised cubicle with bronze plaques sharing each continent's story.



At its heart, a 28-meter Burial Ground is encircled by a circular walkway linked to the monument. The Healing Monument, a Corten steel sculpture with a perforated surface, lets light filter through, symbolizing the journey from sorrow to healing. An adjacent amphitheater for over 360 people and a Rock Garden offer spaces for collective and quiet reflection. Supporting facilities blend discreetly into the landscape.

This living work of art stands at the crossroads of memory, healing, and education, ensuring the legacy of those lost endures. The project, driven by heartfelt collaboration and resilience, honors the victims while inspiring enduring hope and future remembrance.

A NEW ERA FOR AFRICAN HOSPITALITY INNOVATION: HOSPITALITY HACKATHON RECAP



On April 12–13, Ethiopia hosted its first-ever Hospitality Hackathon, a landmark two-day event that brought together over 350 innovators, entrepreneurs, and industry leaders to solve real-world challenges in African hospitality. Hosted across two venues – ALX Lideta Hub and the Pan African Hall at Kuriftu African Village – the event marked a new chapter for collaborative problem-solving in tourism and service.

What made this hackathon unique? The problem statements were drawn directly from operational challenges at Kuriftu Resorts, ensuring that every idea generated was grounded in real need. The event was inspired



by the Cornell University x Hilton Hackathon, but reimagined for the Ethiopian and broader African hospitality context – blending local insight with global ambition.

Day One focused on deep exploration of the four challenge areas, with workshops led by ALX Ethiopia and WeVenture guiding teams through ideation. By the end of the day, over 70 original solutions were developed – from tech-enabled guest services to sustainable resort operations. The day also featured a vibrant panel discussion moderated by Helinna Ayalew, featuring:

- Yonaïel Tadiwos, Operations Director, Kuriftu Resorts
- Yoadan Tilahun, Founder, Flawless Events
- Misikir Adane, Co-founder, Muyaology



Day Two was hosted at the Pan African Hall in Kuriftu African Village, where the top 9 teams pitched their solutions to an esteemed panel of judges. After a powerful round of presentations,

Team Genit was crowned the winner, receiving:

- 150,000 ETB cash prize
- A Kuriftu holiday package
- Access to WeVenture’s incubation program
- Entrepreneurship support from ALX

The winning team was selected by an expert panel of judges:

- Temesgen Gebrehiwot, CEO, ETA Solutions /Zmall
- Tadios Tefera, CTO, MMCY Tech
- Yasser Bagersh, Founder, Cactus Advertising

This was more than a competition – it was the launch of a movement to empower local talent, embrace innovation, and build solutions that can redefine African hospitality from the inside out.

REFLECTIONS FROM ETHIO CYCLING ADVENTURES

Ethio Cycling Adventures (ECA), was set up by Levi Lawrence to promote recreational cycling in Addis. At the time, the target group was expats and tourists looking to explore the city and surrounding areas by bike, as this offered a unique experience, as well as an opportunity to keep fit.

Having mapped out a series of rides, from a city tour to outer suburban rides and more challenging routes up and around Entoto, Levi led small groups of riders and individuals on these tours, with bikes supplied by ECA.

Back then, touring around the city by bike came with its challenges, not least having to share congested roads, filled with older, polluting vehicles, often driven by drivers with little concern for cyclists. Avoiding potholes and open drains also added to the fun and the dreaded mud on the roads during the rainy season left Levi dreaming of a better world for cyclists in Addis.

Returning after eight years, Levi could not believe his eyes! World class, dedicated bike lanes, new tarmac roads and covered drains all over the city. Even more incredible was the amazing new sealed road that goes up and around the Entoto Ranges from Arat Kilo offering spectacular views of Addis and the surrounding countryside. Obviously, a ride up and down Entoto is not for the faint hearted, but it offers a much-improved experience on the old roads and can be ridden by both road and mountain bikes.

Levi's final dream for Addis Ababa is to see its wonderful new bike lanes packed with riders on a daily basis, turning Addis into one of the leading environmentally friendly cycling cities in Africa.

"TAXI RIMBAUD": AN IMAGE IN MOTION

Arthur Rimbaud was born in France in 1854. He wrote his first poems at the age of fifteen but suddenly gave up literature in 1875 to become an explorer, merchant and journalist. From 1880 to 1890, he lived several times in Harar pursuing his childhood dream to live intensely, to be constantly on the move in a frantic quest to explore the unknown.

Emmanuel Benoit has always been fascinated by him. In 2016, Emmanuel moved to Addis Ababa for three years, where he observed the comings and goings of the capital's blue taxis. He then undertook a massive and itinerant installation, pasting Rimbaud's image onto hundreds of Lada taxis in the capital and also on Peugeot 404 taxis of Harar.

« I created a round, more dynamic image, slightly different from the iconic photograph taken by Carjat in 1871, and the idea was to keep the image in motion ».



When he returned to Ethiopia in 2023, Emmanuel continued this project by buying a Peugeot 404 taxi in Harar and driving it back to Addis Ababa.

Emmanuel's Exhibition Statement

« My exhibition will be a unique opportunity to celebrate contemporary art, Ethiopian history and the wonderful adventure of driving my Peugeot 404 taxi through the country's breathtaking landscapes. This journey is a nod to Arthur Rimbaud's expedition to Shoa in 1887 when he went to Entoto to meet Menelik.

It took me three days in November 2024 to reach Entoto from Harar.

My taxi will be presented as the centerpiece of this exhibition. Extracted from the streets of Harar, it will become an art object, whilst remaining a strong image of automobile history in Ethiopia.

A film, shot with a super 8 camera will offer an artistic vision of this journey. Additionally, a few large photos will highlight some of the exceptional design details of the Peugeot 404 styled by the Italian Pininfarina ».

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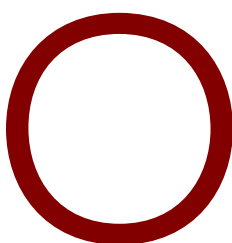
