MESKEL: ETHIOPIA'S RADIANT FESTIVAL OF THE TRUE CROSS

Meskel, celebrated annually on September 27 (or 28 during leap years), is one of Ethiopia's most treasured religious holidays. Rooted in centuries of tradition, the festival commemorates the discovery of the True Cross by Empress Helena, mother of Roman Emperor Constantine, in the 4th century. "Meskel" means "cross" in Ge'ez, and the holiday honors this sacred symbol with vibrant ceremonies, spiritual reflection, and deep community ties.

The celebration begins the night before, on "Demera" Eve. Large bonfires, also called Demera, are lit in city squares and villages across the country. The most famous of these takes place in Meskel Square in Addis Ababa, drawing thousands of people. The bonfire is topped with daisies—called "meskel flowers"—and priests in colorful robes lead processions with chanting, prayers, and the lighting of the fire. According to tradition, the direction in which the fire leans as it burns reveals omens for the coming year.

The next day is filled with church services, feasts, and gatherings with family and neighbors. People wear traditional white garments, and communities prepare and share special holiday dishes. In rural areas, villagers hold smaller but equally meaningful Demera events.

Beyond its religious significance, Meskel is also recognized by UNESCO as an Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity. It reflects Ethiopia's unique fusion of Orthodox Christian faith, ancient customs, and strong communal values.

Meskel is more than a holiday—it is a time of renewal, unity, and joy. Whether witnessed in the heart of Addis Ababa or in a remote village, the glowing Demera fire remains a powerful symbol of hope and spiritual connection that continues to bring Ethiopians together across generations.

KAFFA: A HIDDEN GEM

Ethiopia is known to have a wide variety of ecosystems, ranging from evergreen cloud forests to warm, dry depressions and everything in between. Citing this diversity, Ethiopia is part of one of the world's 35 biodiversity hotspots.

Today, I am taking you some 460KM out of Addis to the Kaffa Biosphere Reserve in South Western Ethiopia, which is widely known to be the birthplace of coffee Arabica, one of the most popular drinks in the world.

In the ancient forests of Kaffa, centuries old wild coffee trees grow and thrive with an incredible variety of as many as 5000 genetic variants. These abundant forests and mountains also give rise to a number of roaring rivers that nourish vast lowland areas and gushing waterfalls such as Barta, endlessly dropping down from cliffs as deep as 70 meters, creating mists and rainbows.

More than 300 animal species, including the majestic Abyssinian Lions with a distinctive black mane, call this place of wonder home. Such dense forests are unlikely habitats for carnivores and predators, but thanks to the French photographer Bruno D'Amicis, who traveled to Ethiopia in 2012 and captured these kings of the jungle in Kaffa, their presence has been confirmed. 224 plant species have been recorded in the area, out of which 20 are listed as endemic. Kaffa is also a paradise to birdwatchers, with as many as 178 colorful birds roaming under its skies.

To top off these and many more natural wonders of the area, spending time with the humble locals of Kaffa whose culture and livelihood revolves around the coffee plant, is an interesting experience, adding a touch of warmth and love to your visit.

This coming Ethiopian New Year, I invite you to visit Kaffa and explore one of the hidden gems of Ethiopia.

Cristina De Luca has lived in Ethiopia for 10 years along with her family. 20 years ago, while studying architecture in Rome, she met fellow student Ethiopian Ettore; they married 12 years ago and have 2 beautiful daughters.

By nature, she had always been intolerant of rules and regulations and so she felt as if she was trapped in a kind of cocoon. However, after visiting Ethiopia she started to free herself.

After their master degrees in architectural design, the couple decided to move and settle in Ethiopia. Motivated by solid values of honesty, community and positivism, it was initially quite challenging having to adapt to a different way of working and thinking. But the most important thing was becoming masters of their own lives and with a mere 200 euros in their pockets, perseverance and determination, they were able to launch their own architectural company (4D Studio), followed by a furniture factory.

Cristina is now running her own textile business AURADORO CROSS-CULTURAL FASHION: creating bags, accessories and clothing using Ethiopian handwoven fabrics, mixed with premium quality leather combining all the colourful and cultural aspects of living in international Addis promoting cultural exchanges at different levels.

“We love to mix our fabrics and designs to create something unique including collaborating with local artisans and creating a strong community based on unity in diversity. My dream is to grow together with all the people working with us, being able to export our products to other African countries, showing the beauty of handwoven Ethiopian fabrics.”

CLASSIC BUTTER COOKIES

Ingredients:

- 1 cup (225g) unsalted butter, softened
- ⅔ cup (80g) powdered sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 cups (250g) all-purpose flour
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- Optional for decorating:
 - o Powdered sugar (for dusting)
 - o Melted chocolate
 - o Sprinkles

Instructions:

1. Preheat the Oven

Preheat your oven to 350°F (175°C). Line a baking sheet with parchment paper.

2. Cream the Butter and Sugar

In a large bowl, beat the softened butter and powdered sugar together until light and fluffy.

3. Add Vanilla

Mix in the vanilla extract until well combined.

4. Add the Dry Ingredients

Gradually add the flour and salt to the butter mixture, mixing until a soft dough forms.

5. Shape the Cookies

Use a piping bag, cookie press, or roll-and-cut method to shape the dough into desired cookie shapes. Place them on the prepared baking sheet, leaving space between each cookie.

Optional: If the dough is too soft, chill it for 15–20 minutes to make it easier to handle.

6. Bake

Bake in the preheated oven for 10–12 minutes, or until the edges are lightly golden.

7. Cool

Remove from the oven and let the cookies cool on the baking sheet for 5 minutes. Then transfer them to a wire rack to cool completely.

8. Decorate and Serve

Once cooled, dust with powdered sugar for a simple finish, or drizzle with melted chocolate and top with sprinkles for a festive touch.

OVERSIMPLIFIED: IS ARCHITECTURE LOSING ITS SOUL?

Across the globe, architecture and design are increasingly dominated by a sterile, overly simplified aesthetic. What once was a meaningful minimalist movement has now become a shortcut—repeated, replicated, and reproduced at speed. Under pressure to build faster and cheaper, developers and designers are leaning on templated forms that lack context, identity, and cultural relevance.

We continue to copy what is easy: flat façades, generic palettes, and international styles that could belong to any city in the world. But in doing so, we risk eroding the very integrity of the profession. Architecture is not just about shelter or style—it's about crafting spaces that reflect who we are, where we are, and how we live.

This loss is particularly visible when contrasted with the richness of older buildings that demanded skill, detail, and thought. Take, for example, the National Bank of Ethiopia—a striking example of modern Ethiopian architecture, designed by Chomette in 1965. A student of Le Corbusier, Chomette's design combined modernist elements with local materials.

This is not just a local problem. It's global. But the consequence is the same: a diminishing connection between people and place, between culture and craft.

But it doesn't have to be one or the other. The future of architecture can be both refined and rooted. By blending today's innovations with timeless craftsmanship and cultural sensitivity, we can design buildings that are efficient—yet full of meaning. Simplicity doesn't need to erase identity. It can frame it.


