THE GRAND FENDIKA – A STAGE FOR THE STREET IN ADDIS ABABA

World renowned Italian architectural firm CRA-Carlo Ratti Associati has unveiled the design for the Grand Fendika Cultural Center, a new civic space in the heart of Addis Ababa, created in collaboration with Fendika's founder, Melaku Belay. The project was developed in partnership with Fendika's local and global communities and made possible through the financial support of TrustAfrica, a Pan African foundation headquartered in Dakar, Senegal. The project builds on decades of grassroots work to sustain indigenous Ethiopian performance traditions in a rapidly changing city. Fendika, the last azmari bet of its kind in the area, had been revived by Melaku in 2008 and earned international acclaim.

The new building remains deliberately open to its surroundings. Its design emphasizes porous boundaries, allowing music to drift into the street. Rather than replacing what already exists, the building gives it space to grow, remaining deeply connected to its neighborhood and its history.

The new building translates Fendika's long-standing connection to its community into physical form, starting from the street. At Fendika, the building takes that idea seriously—making the street itself part of the performance. A gently sloping stair-ramp begins at ground level and rises toward a rooftop terrace, weaving through performance halls, classrooms, rehearsal studios, artist residences, archives, a café, and an open-air stage. Double-height spaces and interwoven staircases link the four levels, allowing visitors to move organically between them, always within earshot of music or performance.

Fendika has partnered with Hyatt Regency and revived their concerts (since losing their original site in 2024) and Azmari programs. The municipality of Addis Ababa recognized the value of Fendika's work and has allowed them to rebuild Fendika on the original site.

SHAKSHUKA

INGREDIENTS

2 tbsp extra virgin olive oil
1 large onion, chopped
1 to 2 green bell peppers, chopped
2 garlic cloves, minced
1 tsp ground coriander
1 tsp ground cumin
1 tsp paprika
1/4 tsp red pepper flakes (optional, for heat)
Salt, to taste
6 medium-sized fresh tomatoes, diced (or 1 28-ounce can of whole tomatoes, drained and chopped)
1/2 cup tomato sauce (optional, for a smoother texture)
6 large eggs

Optional Garnishes:

Fresh parsley, chopped
Fresh mint, chopped
Crumbled feta cheese (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Heat olive oil in a large, heavy skillet or pan (with a lid) over medium heat.
2. Add the chopped onion, bell peppers, and minced garlic. Season with a pinch of salt.
3. Stir in the coriander, cumin, paprika, and red pepper flakes (if using). Cook for about 5 minutes, stirring occasionally, until the vegetables are soft and fragrant.
4. Add the diced fresh tomatoes and tomato sauce (if using). Stir everything together, bring to a boil, then reduce the heat to low. Let it simmer uncovered for 15 minutes, stirring occasionally, until the sauce has thickened and the flavors meld together.
5. Once the sauce is ready, use the back of a spoon to create 6 small wells in the sauce.
6. Crack one egg into each well, being careful not to break the yolk. Cover the skillet with a lid and let the eggs cook over medium-low heat until the whites are set, but the yolks remain soft and runny (about 6-8 minutes).
7. Once the eggs are done, remove from heat. Garnish with chopped parsley and mint for a burst of freshness and color. If desired, sprinkle with crumbled feta cheese for extra creaminess.

Serve immediately with your favorite bread for dipping (pita, crusty loaf, or challah are all excellent choices).

Apart from being featured in Vogue (Italy), Zemenay has participated on different stages both nationally and internationally including Hub of Africa fashion week for three consecutive years, Berlin fashion week's Neo fashion platform in Germany, Cape Town week of fashion and CANEX at Intra African trade fair held in Egypt, Cairo.





ELNET FOUNDATION MOBILE VETERINARY CLINIC

Animals are part of our lives and their well-being affects us in various ways; through their labour among the working equines; through their contribution as farm animals or companionship as pets, and even as wildlife tourism attractions.

However, when animals suffer, our ecosystem suffers. Contagious and infectious diseases can spread through improper disposal of carcasses and unvaccinated populations of stray dogs and other animals. Abandoned large animals like horses, donkeys and mules can also pose road safety threats. That is why Elnet has a One Health approach – seeing our living environment as one holistic system where one part cannot function properly without the other – through practical action combined with raising awareness and advocacy.

The large number of abandoned equines, horses, donkeys and mules, face the likelihood of spending their final years abandoned on the road side, having to fend for their own survival by eating scraps, finding grass and water on their own and having no one to care for them when they get sick or injured.

At Elnet Foundation, we are determined to bring a change by introducing a state-of-the-art mobile veterinary clinic. The mobile veterinary clinic will provide free services to abandoned equines, whilst providing both clinical services, as well as training and awareness to equine owners.

By working closely with the Directorate of Animal Health of the Ministry of Agriculture, our ambition is to see this becoming institutionalized in the long run. Our MVC travels to where help is needed most, offering on-site treatment, health checks, and owner education to promote long-term equine welfare.
