

HONORING A MAESTRO:

ETHIOPIA'S ASHENAFI KEBEDE PERFORMING ARTS CENTER

In June 2024, Addis Ababa University inaugurated the **Ashenafi Kebede Performing Arts Center** at the Yared School of Music, a milestone in Ethiopia's cultural and educational landscape. Named after **Professor Ashenafi Kebede (1938–1998)**, a composer, ethnomusicologist, and pioneering music educator, the center celebrates his enduring legacy and provides a modern hub for performance and learning.

Ashenafi Kebede was instrumental in shaping Ethiopia's formal music education. After studying abroad at the Eastman School of Music and Wesleyan University, he returned home to become the first director of the Yared School of Music. Known for blending Ethiopian traditional music with global influences, his compositions – such as *Koturasia* – bridged cultural boundaries. Kebede also documented Ethiopia's rich musical heritage, particularly the art of the *azmari*, and authored scholarly works including *Roots of Black Music*.

The performing arts center embodies Kebede's vision of music as both cultural preservation and



innovation. Equipped with a modern auditorium, rehearsal spaces, and classrooms, it serves as a venue for local and international performances while nurturing the next generation of Ethiopian musicians. Prime Minister **Abiy Ahmed**, who inaugurated the center, emphasized its role in enlightening youth and harnessing Ethiopia's cultural wealth.

Under the leadership of pianist **Girma Yifrashewa**, the center aims to foster a vibrant cultural exchange and inspire young artists to explore Ethiopia's musical heritage. By offering performance opportunities, education, and international collaboration, it is set to become a cornerstone of Ethiopia's cultural revival.

WOMEN'S HEALTH: UNDERSTANDING PCOS

SYMPTOMS, CAUSES, AND WHY IT MATTERS

Polycystic ovary syndrome (PCOS) is a hormonal condition affecting 1 in 10 women of reproductive age. While its name suggests “cysts on the ovaries,” PCOS is more than just an ovarian issue. It’s a systemic issue that can impact fertility, metabolism, and overall health.

What are the signs of PCOS?

Women with PCOS often experience:

- Irregular periods (or no periods at all).
- Acne, oily skin, or unwanted hair growth on the face/body.
- Thinning hair on the scalp.
- Weight gain or difficulty losing weight (but rarely, thin women can have PCOS).
- Trouble getting pregnant.

Doctors diagnose PCOS if you have at least two of these three criteria:

- Irregular ovulation
- High “male hormones” (androgens), Or
- Cysts on the ovaries (seen via ultrasound).

Why does PCOS happen?

The exact cause is unclear, but several factors play a role:

1. Genetics: PCOS often runs in families.
2. Hormonal Imbalance: High insulin levels (from insulin resistance) trigger the ovaries to produce excess androgens, disrupting ovulation.
3. Lifestyle & Environment: Poor diet, inactivity, chronic stress, and exposure to endocrine disrupting chemicals (in plastics or cosmetics) can worsen symptoms.

CHOCOLATE LAVA CAKE FOR TWO

WHY IT'S PERFECT

- Rich, indulgent, and romantic
- Ready in 15 minutes
- Minimal ingredients

INGREDIENTS:

- 100 g dark chocolate
- ½ cup butter
- 2 eggs
- ¼ cup sugar
- 2 tbsp all-purpose flour
- 1 tsp vanilla essence
- Pinch of salt
- Cocoa powder or powdered sugar (for dusting)

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Preheat the oven to 200°C. Grease two small ramekins or oven-safe cups.
2. Melt the chocolate and butter together (double boiler or microwave). Stir until smooth.
3. In a bowl, whisk eggs and sugar until slightly fluffy.
4. Add melted chocolate, vanilla, and salt. Mix well.
5. Gently fold in the flour.
6. Pour batter into ramekins.
7. Bake for 8–10 minutes. The edges should be set, but the center is soft.
8. Let rest for 1 minute, turn onto a plate, and dust with cocoa or powdered sugar.

SERVE WITH:

- Fresh strawberries
- Vanilla ice cream
- A drizzle of honey or chocolate sauce



ITALIANS OF ETHIOPIA AFTER 1941

*“Memory is the treasure of the soul”
– Italian Proverb*

Whoever will look into the history of Italians in Ethiopia, will find plenty of information about the conflicts and tensions between the two nations: Adwa (1896), the Second Italo-Ethiopian War (1935-1936), which led to the Fascist occupation (1936-1941)...

But there's another, lesser-known story: the one of the Italians who stayed in Ethiopia after 1941. During this period, under the second reign of Emperor Haile Selassie I (1941-1974), Ethiopia moved beyond the trauma of war and forged a new relationship with the Italian community.

No longer invaders, Italians became workers, entrepreneurs, and families who built deep personal and economic ties with Ethiopia.

The Com.It.Es Ethiopia is the representative organisation of the Italian citizens living in the country and decided to develop a project to share this barely told story, undertaking an extensive work of collecting and preserving life stories of Italians who lived in Ethiopia during the imperial period (1941-1974).

The final goal is to offer a rich and personal account of the Italian presence in Ethiopia—one that goes beyond political events and focuses on the human stories behind the history.

A website has been developed, sharing abundant materials about the Italian presence in Ethiopia: a timeline, academic articles, magazines and historical docu-films from the Italian television.

KORESHEM! THE TASTE OF ETHIOPIA: *A JOURNEY THROUGH BELOVED SNACK FOODS*

In Ethiopia, snacks are more than something to nibble on—they are a way of connecting, sharing, and celebrating together. *Koreshem!* a local expression meaning “bite the crispy,” perfectly captures the joy found in these simple yet meaningful foods. Every bite tells a story, passed between hands, enjoyed during moments of pause, and woven into the timeless ritual of coffee and conversation.

Among the most iconic snacks is *kolo*, a mix of roasted grains such as barley, wheat, sorghum, chickpeas, and peanuts, lightly seasoned with salt or spices. Sold by street vendors in paper cones, it’s a crunchy, nutritious favorite found everywhere from busy city streets to quiet village markets. A sweeter version, *sweet roasted kolo*, is lightly sugared and often enjoyed during gatherings or alongside coffee.


Dabo kolo, small baked or fried pieces of spiced dough, are Ethiopia’s answer to savory pretzels—perfect for snacking on the go. *Fendisha*, simple popped maize, is commonly served during the traditional coffee ceremony, while roasted chickpeas, seasoned with cumin or paprika, offer a hearty and healthy crunch.

Though not originally Ethiopian, *sambusas*—crispy triangular pastries filled with lentils, meat, or vegetables—have become a beloved part of festive snack culture.

Today, Ethiopia’s snack traditions continue to evolve. Ancient grains like *teff* now appear as *teff* and *injera* chips, offering a modern, gluten-free twist on tradition. Together, these snacks reflect a living culinary culture—one bite at a time.


