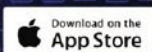

BEHAILU BEZABIH: A LIFE IN MOTION

Born in 1960 in Addis Ababa, Behailu Bezabih was a leading figure in Ethiopian contemporary art—an innovative painter and dedicated educator whose influence spanned more than four decades. His passing in April 2026 marks the loss of a powerful creative voice that helped shape the country’s modern visual identity.

Known for his spontaneous and experimental style, Behailu’s work captured what he described as a “world of fast-moving ideas.” Using acrylics, oils, and mixed media on both canvas and unconventional materials, his paintings reflected the rhythm and complexity of everyday Ethiopian life. From vibrant cityscapes to the dynamic “Gullit” (local street market), his art documented urban culture with both depth and immediacy.



Humor and social commentary were central to his practice. In series like *Gates*, Behailu portrayed scenes from daily life—including Tej Bet gatherings—with a light yet insightful touch, revealing the nuances of social interaction and shared experience.

A graduate and later instructor at the Alle School of Fine Arts and Design, he played a vital role in mentoring young artists, particularly in new media. His teaching legacy remains as impactful as his artwork. Beyond his professional achievements, Behailu was widely known for his kindness, humility, and generosity of spirit, qualities that deeply endeared him to his students, peers, and the wider artistic community.

Behailu exhibited widely, both locally and internationally, including at institutions such as the Irish Museum of Modern Art and the Goethe-Institut. He received major recognitions, including the Pollock-Krasner Award in 2013.

As a founding member of the Dimension Group, Behailu helped shape Ethiopia's contemporary art movement. Today, he is remembered not only for his authenticity and creativity, but also for the warmth and humility that defined his life and legacy.

ETHIOPIAN TATTOOS: A LIVING TRADITION OF FAITH AND IDENTITY

Ethiopian tattoos, locally known as the traditional Nikisat (ንቅሳት), are among the country's oldest cultural traditions, reflecting a unique blend of faith, beauty, and identity. Practiced for centuries, they are most common in the northern highlands of Tigray and Amhara, though variations exist across Ethiopia's diverse ethnic groups.

Historically, Nikisat served multiple purposes. For women, these tattoos were often a rite of passage into adulthood, marking beauty, social status, and community belonging. Designs typically appear on the face, neck, hands, and gums, with forehead crosses, chin dots, chain-like neck patterns, and darkened gums being the most common. Each motif carries meaning: crosses symbolize Christian faith, while patterns around the neck and hands were believed to protect the wearer from illness and evil spirits.

The tradition is deeply intertwined with Ethiopian Orthodox Christianity. Many motifs are inspired by church iconography and local interpretations of sacred symbols. Oral histories describe how women would carry these marks with pride, embodying both spiritual devotion and personal identity.





Regional differences are notable. In Tigray, forehead crosses and cheek dots are common, while in Gondar and Gojjam, women often have elaborate neck and chest patterns. Southern communities, such as the Oromo or Gurage, may use facial or hand marks to denote clan affiliation or age grade rather than religious symbolism. Pastoralist groups in the Omo Valley are better known for scarification, but these practices share the same underlying principles of identity and beauty.

In modern times, Nikisat is declining due to urbanization, changing beauty standards, and health concerns. Yet, cultural activists and contemporary Ethiopian tattoo artists are reinterpreting these ancient motifs, preserving their historical, spiritual, and artistic significance. Nikisat remains a powerful symbol of Ethiopia's rich heritage, connecting the past to the present through art, faith, and personal expression.

BAMBOO LABS

Bamboo Labs, a four-year-old Ethiopian social enterprise known for its innovative bicycles and wheelchairs crafted from the bamboo tree, is preparing to expand operations into Kenya. Abel Hailegiorgis, the company's founder, explained that their first activities are scheduled to begin with a two-week training program in Nairobi. He added that the necessary manufacturing inputs, including transport and shipping for nearly 100 bamboo bicycles, have already been secured. "Kenya has the next largest bamboo resource in Africa," Abel said. "We hope to replicate our operations there."

Ethiopia is home to two major bamboo species: highland bamboo and lowland bamboo. Both thrive across the country's varied ecological zones. Covering more than 1.4 million hectares, Ethiopia accounts for roughly 7 percent of the world's bamboo resources. Kenya, by comparison, has slightly over 150,000 hectares of natural bamboo.



Abel Hailegiorgis is the founder and CEO of Bamboo Labs, the award-winning social enterprise that promotes affordable, accessible, and sustainable transport mobility by utilizing renewable resources, to create a positive environmental impact. Bamboo Labs is producing wheelchairs and bicycles made out of bamboo for the local and export market. Abel is also a Young African Leaders Initiative (YALI) alumni.

Bamboo Labs is committed to providing affordable, reliable, and sustainable transportation solutions that are not only accessible but also environmentally friendly. In addition to producing wheelchairs and bicycles, Bamboo Labs has plans to expand its product line to include bamboo bike frames for export, which will further contribute to the growth of the local economy.

Bamboo, the fastest-growing and most regenerative plant on Earth, has attracted attention for its eco-friendly properties and strength, which in some applications rival steel. In recent years, bamboo has gained recognition in global climate action discussions.

CREAMY FRENCH ONION CHICKEN PASTA BAKE



Time and Servings

- Prep: 15m
- Cook: 10m
- Serves: 4

Ingredients

- 250g penne pasta
- 1 tbsp olive oil
- 200g thickly sliced button mushrooms
- 6 fresh thyme sprigs, leaves removed
- 1 barbecue chicken, bones removed, meat and skin shredded
- 40g packet French Onion Soup mix
- 60g baby spinach
- 375ml (1 1/2 cups) Full Cream Milk
- 125ml (1/2 cup) Thickened Cream

Step 1

Grease a large baking dish. Cook pasta following packet directions. Drain. Meanwhile, heat oil in a large, deep-frying pan over high heat. Add mushrooms and thyme. Cook, stirring occasionally, for 3 minutes or until softened.

Step 2

Preheat the oven grill on high. Add the chicken, French onion mix, spinach, milk, cream and half the cheese to the mushroom mixture. Bring to a simmer. Stir in the pasta. Season.

Step 3

Transfer the pasta mixture to prepared dish. Sprinkle with remaining cheese. Grill for 2-3 minutes or until golden. Top with parsley.

WOMEN'S HEALTH PART 1: GUT HEALTH AND INFERTILITY



A client struggles to conceive, undergoes the standard fertility workup and is told everything looks "normal." The resulting diagnosis? Unexplained Infertility.

For the woman on the receiving end, this label is a dead end. If the basic labs are fine, where do you go? The focus remains narrowly on hormones and anatomy, leaving many to feel hopeless or that their condition is a mystery.

However, the body is not a collection of separate parts. It is a deeply intertwined system. While standard hormone tests are a good starting point, they only scratch the surface. They fail to account for complex physiological processes happening beneath the surface specifically, in the gut.

What if the root cause isn't in the ovaries, but rather in the digestive tract? Next month, we explore in detail how gut health affects infertility.

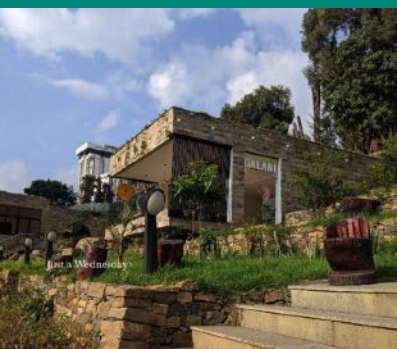

THE BOY WHO RODE THE WOODEN BIKE



Kidus Tesera, known as “Kius King” or the “Wooden King,” is a British cyclist of Ethiopian origin who built a fully functional bicycle entirely from wood. With no prior woodworking experience and limited cycling background, he spent two months designing and constructing the bike during a gap year, turning a bold idea into reality.

Born in Ethiopia and raised in the UK, Kidus studied biochemistry at university before choosing to take a break and pursue an unusual personal challenge. Despite doubts from friends and family, he committed to building and riding his handmade wooden bicycle, embracing creativity, resilience, and independence.

He went on to cycle across the UK, from northern Scotland to Dover and later to Land’s End. Along the way, he documented his journey and raised funds for Age UK in the UK and Mekedonia Humanitarian Association in Ethiopia, supporting vulnerable elderly communities.

His journey gained attention online and inspired many through its message of determination and generosity. It showed how an unconventional idea, combined with persistence, can create meaningful impact.

Kidus has since published a book titled *The Boy Who Rode the Wooden Bike*, sharing his story of imagination, courage, and self-belief. The book follows a young boy who dares to build a wooden bicycle and sets off on a life-changing journey, learning that bold dreams can take you further than fear ever will.

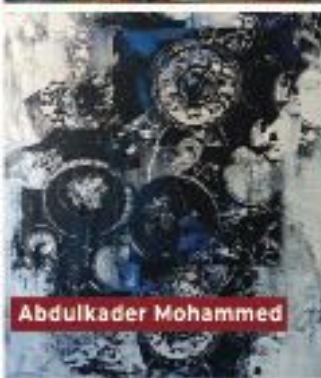

ROCK CLIMBING FOR CHANGE: ETHIOPIA'S CLIMBING NGO MOVEMENT

Climbing in Ethiopia is no longer just an extreme sport or tourist thrill – it's becoming a vehicle for social change, environmental stewardship, and community empowerment. Through local initiatives and international support, climbing organizations in Ethiopia are building capacity to make the sport more accessible, sustainable, and community-centered.

One standout example is the Global Climbing Initiative (GCI)'s support for Rock Climbing Ethiopia. This partnership provides training to establish a strong climbing community in Addis Ababa and beyond. A core part of the program is the Gear Distribution Program, which ensures that local climbers, who traditionally lack access to climbing equipment, can train safely and confidently.

Locally, climbers have organized around famous basalt rock crags like Amora Gedel, just outside Addis Ababa. There's a shared vision of preserving cliffside areas through responsible climbing practices and working with landholders for mutually beneficial agreements. For instance, a nominal daily fee helps maintain access and keep the sites clean, while fostering local ownership and respect.





Moreover, this climbing-led movement intersects with environmental NGOs such as Nature Ethiopia, which works on ecosystem restoration, forest management, and climate resilience. By collaborating with climbing groups, these NGOs can engage youth and outdoor enthusiasts in conservation work, turning climbers into advocates for nature.

This fusion of adventure, conservation, and community development is powerful. As Ethiopian climbers scale new heights, they're also building infrastructure, raising environmental awareness, and strengthening local economies. The result? A climbing culture that's rooted in responsibility, empowerment, and sustainable growth – a model for climbing communities around the world.

EARS ETHIOPIAN ANIMAL RESCUE & SANCTUARY: LISTENING WITH THE HEART



EARS was founded to respond to Ethiopia's largely unseen animal welfare crisis with compassion, structure, and long-term vision. Every day, dogs, cats, donkeys, and horses suffer from preventable injuries, disease, and neglect - often without access to veterinary care or safe shelter.

What began as emergency rescue quickly became something more. EARS works at the intersection of animal welfare, public health, and community development. We rescue and rehabilitate vulnerable animals, but we also focus on education, humane population control, and building local capacity - because lasting change must address root causes, not only symptoms.

Starting a sanctuary from scratch, however, is not easy. EARS urgently needs help to cover land lease costs and to source essential building materials such as wooden poles, bamboo sheets, metal sheets and water tanks to create safe shelters. Veterinary bills for emergency treatments, vaccinations, and ongoing care are another critical and immediate need.

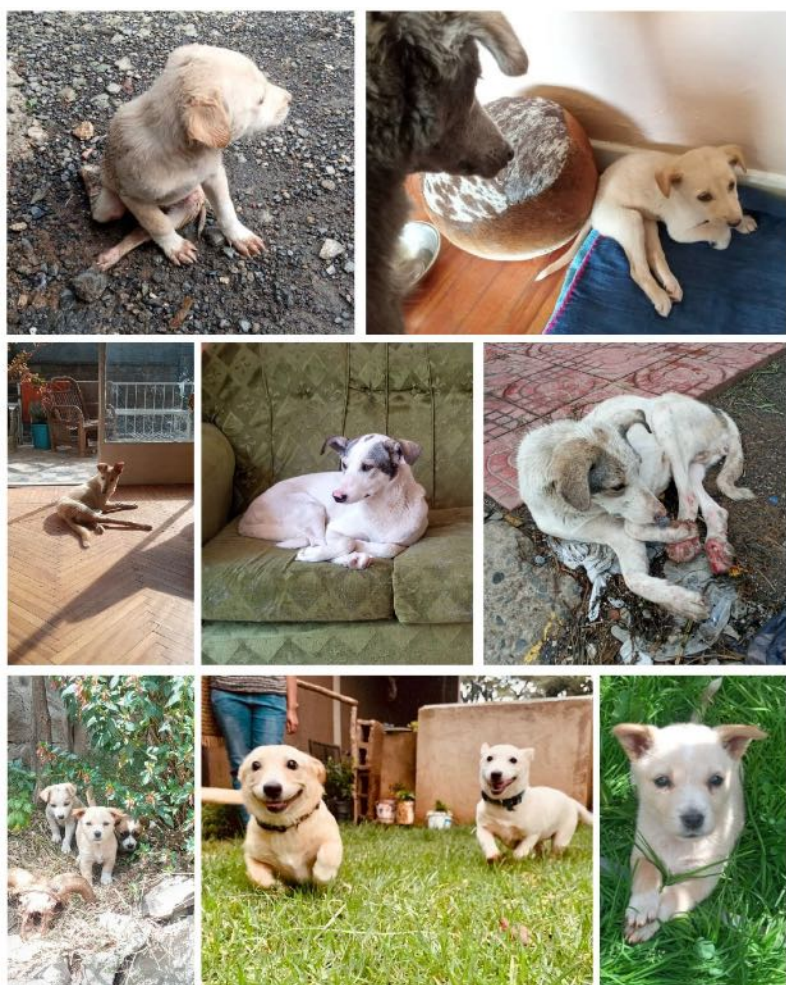
Currently, EARS is establishing a permanent sanctuary outside Addis Ababa: a safe haven for animals who cannot return to the streets; some rehomed through ethical adoption; others will receive lifelong care. Alongside dog or horse food, financial support, EARS warmly welcomes volunteers - people who simply want to spend time with rescued dogs, offer comfort and socialization, or quietly sit with horses and donkeys who are finally learning what safety feels like.

Our work is careful, transparent, and deeply human. Sometimes rescue means healing. Sometimes it means easing suffering when healing is no longer possible. In all cases, dignity comes first. We protect animals while strengthening communities through jobs, training, and awareness. Compassion is not a luxury, but a responsibility.





