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THE LIVING METAL:

INSIDE SANDRO SANTILLI'S AFRICAN JOURNEY

IRONAFRIKA is a name that merges two powerful ideas—"iron" and "Africa." In the practice of metal sculptor Sandro Santilli, it represents a deeper artistic language where industrial metal is transformed into expressive sculptural form, shaped by memory, environment, and imagination rooted in Africa.

Led by Santilli, IRONAFRIKA reflects over 40 years of dedication to metal sculpting and contemporary African art. Although Italian by nationality, he was born in Ethiopia in 1959, and today lives and works in Debre Zeit (Bishoftu). Ethiopia has profoundly shaped his artistic vision, identity, and creative language. Its landscapes, culture, and evolving art scene continue to influence his work, positioning him within a unique space between personal experience and broader African artistic narratives.

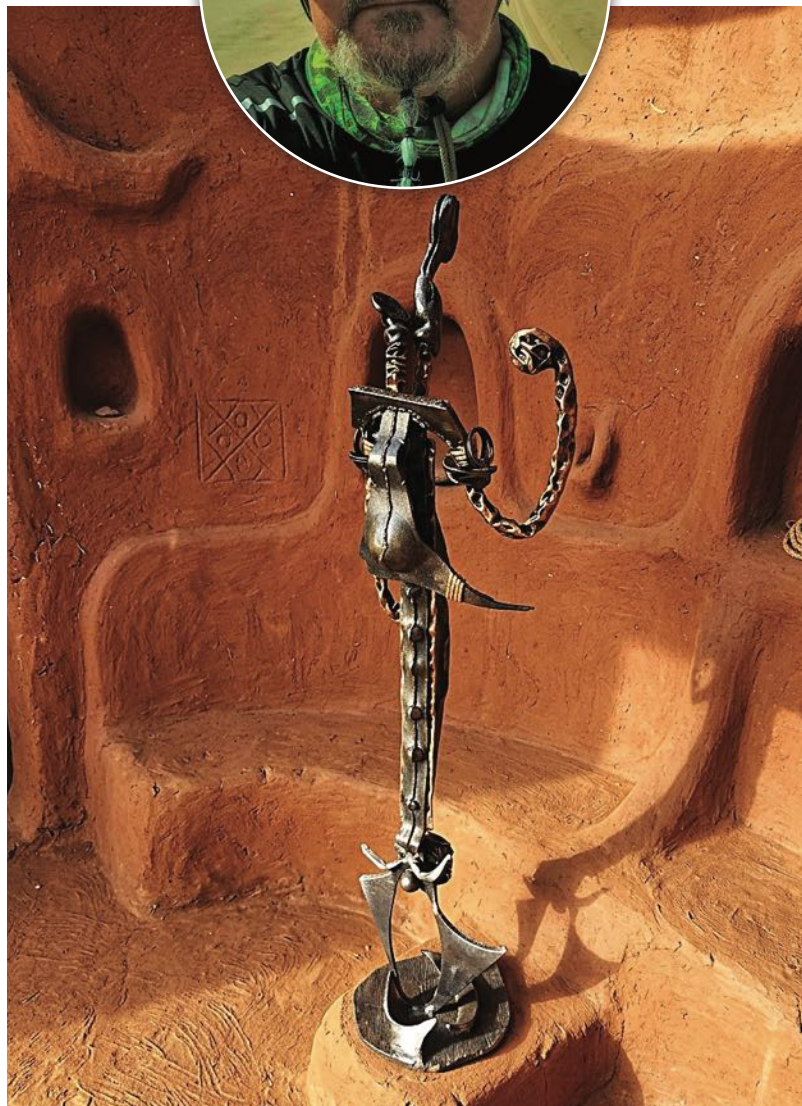
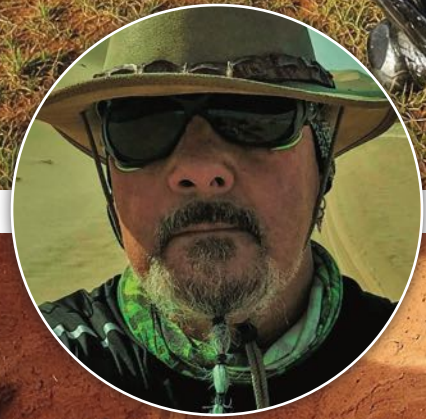
Santilli's relationship with metal began in his childhood, in his father's workshop filled with discarded mechanical parts, engines, and scrap materials. What others saw as waste, he saw as possibility—raw material waiting to be transformed. This early exposure became the foundation of his lifelong artistic practice.

Today, he works primarily with reclaimed iron and steel, using techniques such as cutting, welding, and reshaping. Rather than forcing rigid forms, he allows the material to guide the process. Imperfection, texture, and transformation are not hidden but embraced as essential elements of his work.

IRONAFRIKA is more than a studio practice—it is a long-standing creative identity. Santilli draws inspiration from African landscapes, symbolism, and human movement, creating works that balance abstraction with emotional depth. His sculptures exist in a dynamic tension between control and spontaneity, where industrial materials are softened into expressive forms.

Through IRONAFRIKA, Santilli continues to redefine metal as a living artistic language one shaped by memory, fire, and continuous transformation.

TEGENE KUNBI: SHAPING SILENCE AND IDENTITY AT THE VENICE BIENNALE 2026

Tegene Kunbi is one of Ethiopia's leading contemporary artists, internationally known for his abstract paintings that explore color, texture, and cultural memory. Born in 1980 in Addis Ababa, he studied Painting and Art Education at the University of Addis Ababa, Fine Arts School, and later completed his MFA at the Universität der Künste Berlin through a DAAD scholarship, building a practice that bridges Ethiopia and Europe.

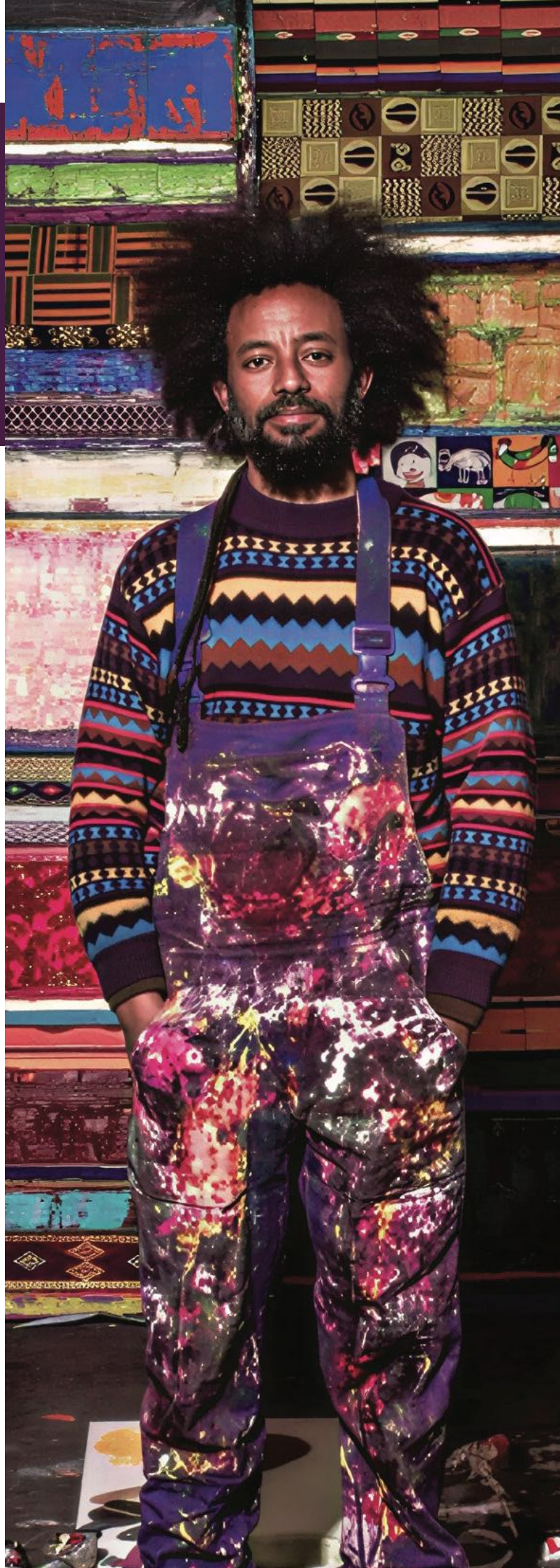
His work is defined by layered compositions of geometric forms, rich color fields, and textured surfaces inspired by Ethiopian textile traditions. Through repetition, structure, and material depth, Kunbi transforms familiar cultural patterns into contemporary abstract languages.

Central to his practice are themes of identity, migration, and memory. Living between Ethiopia and Germany, he reflects on displacement and cultural continuity, using abstraction to express emotional and historical experiences rather than literal representation.

Tegene Kunbi will represent Ethiopia at the Venice Biennale 2026. His exhibition, titled "Shapes of Silence," is curated by Abebaw Ayalew and will be presented at Palazzo Bollani. The project marks a significant milestone in his career, positioning Ethiopian contemporary art on one of the world's most important artistic platforms.

His participation highlights Ethiopia's growing presence in global contemporary art and reflects the evolution of a new generation of African artists working within international dialogues while remaining rooted in local heritage. The exhibition is expected to present a powerful meditation on silence, structure, and memory through abstraction. It also reinforces his role as a key voice in contemporary Ethiopian painting today.

CHICKEN STUFFED CHEESY GARLIC BREAD

Crispy on the outside, soft inside, and loaded with cheesy chicken stuffing – perfect bakery-style garlic bread at home!

INGREDIENTS:

FOR DOUGH:

- All purpose flour – 1 cup
- Sugar – 2 tsp
- Yeast – 1 tsp
- Salt – to taste
- Lukewarm milk – as needed
- Oil – 1 tbsp

FOR CHICKEN FILLING:

- Oil – 2 tbsp
- Onion – 1 tbsp (chopped)
- Green chili – 2 pieces (chopped)
- Chicken keema – 1/2 cup
- Salt – to taste
- Garlic – 1/2 tsp
- Ginger – 1/2 tsp
- Pepper powder – to taste
- Oregano – to taste
- Spring onion – to taste
- All purpose flour – 2 tsp
- Milk – 1/4 cup

FOR GARLIC BUTTER:

- Butter – 2 tbsp (softened)
- Coriander – 1 tbsp (chopped)
- Garlic – 1 tsp (chopped)
- Chili flakes – to taste
- Salt – a pinch
- Oregano – a pinch

FOR ASSEMBLY:

- Mozzarella cheese – as needed

INSTRUCTIONS:

Prepare Dough:

In a bowl, mix flour, sugar, yeast, and salt. Add lukewarm milk gradually and oil, then knead for 5 minutes until soft and smooth. Rub oil on the dough, cover, and rest for 30 minutes.

PREPARE CHICKEN FILLING:

Heat oil in a pan, add onion and green chili, cook for 2 minutes. Add chicken keema, salt, garlic, ginger, pepper, oregano, and spring onion. Cook for 2 minutes. Add flour, mix well, then pour in milk. Cook for 5 minutes until thick and creamy. Keep aside.

PREPARE GARLIC BUTTER:

Mix butter, coriander, chopped garlic, chili flakes, salt, and oregano until well combined.

ASSEMBLE GARLIC BREAD:

Roll the rested dough into a rectangle. Spread garlic butter, add chicken stuffing, and sprinkle mozzarella cheese. Seal the edges properly. Spread garlic butter on top and make cuts.

BAKE:

Bake in a preheated oven at 160°C for 10–15 minutes or until golden and crispy. Slice and serve hot.



FROM WASTE TO WEARABLE ART:

HOW AN ETHIOPIAN CREATOR IS REDEFINING DIGITAL FASHION STORYTELLING

In today's fast-moving digital landscape, where attention is often driven by trends, paid collaborations, and algorithmic boosts, a different kind of creative success story is quietly emerging from Ethiopia, one built on authenticity, visual storytelling, and consistency.

An Ethiopian content creator is drawing growing international attention not through conventional influencer strategies, but through a deeply original artistic concept: transforming discarded and "unwanted" materials into striking fashion statements.

Torn clothing, worn-out shoes, and overlooked everyday waste are reimagined into wearable pieces that challenge perception and redefine value. What many would dismiss as trash becomes, through his creative process, a bold visual expression of identity, sustainability, and imagination.

At the core of this work is a simple but powerful idea, nothing is truly worthless until it is seen without possibility.

From a marketing and digital media perspective, this rise is particularly significant. The creator's success is not driven by high-budget production or extensive networking within established fashion circles. Instead, it is rooted in three key elements that increasingly define digital relevance today.

First, authenticity. The concept is not constructed to follow existing trends; rather, it stands as a trend in itself. In a digital environment saturated with repetition, originality becomes the strongest currency.

Second, visual clarity and storytelling. Each transformation is instantly readable. The audience does not need explanation to understand the concept, making the content universally accessible across cultures and languages. This type of visual communication aligns strongly with global platform algorithms, where engagement is often driven by immediate comprehension and emotional reaction.

Third, consistency. Beyond frequent posting, there is a recognizable identity in every piece of content. This repetition of concept, without losing creativity, builds familiarity, which in turn strengthens audience retention and trust.



Perhaps most notably, this growth has not followed the traditional "local first, then global" pathway often associated with emerging creators. There was no structured push into international markets or reliance on established media amplification. Instead, the content itself traveled organically, propelled by its visual impact and conceptual strength.

In a digital era where visibility is often manufactured, this story stands as a reminder that powerful ideas do not always need permission to spread. Sometimes, all they need is to be seen.

ETHIOPIA AND ITS COFFEE TRADITIONS

Across the Western World, modern coffee shops offer "Coffee served in Luscious Grass Fed Butter, and Sea Salt from the Baltics", descriptions that sound well informed and sophisticated. In reality this is what every "Gurage" house drinks every day, able to pour "with, or without butter" from the "Jebena".

Salt in Ethiopia originates from the salt lakes of Afar, 100 meters below sea level full of antioxidant properties, and our Cows from Fogera, are amazingly strong and can resist drought. More sturdy and real, than luscious grass fields.

In Ethiopia, all the above is innate, coffee is drunk in so many varied methods and for thousands of years before anyone else even smelled the drink. In Oromia, celebrating big events, Bunakela is served, coffee beans in dried pods, cooked in butter, tasting like chocolate. In Harar, there is Hasher Kahwa, coffee mixed with the coffee husks, and roasted with Spices. Hoja is a coffee brewed with the dried and roasted coffee leaves, mixed with spices and milk.

The Ethiopian Coffee Ceremony is world famous by now, people sitting in a circle, presided over by a beautiful lady covered in the smell of roasted beans and incense, evoking togetherness and spirituality.

Ethiopian coffee goes beyond the drink, it is mystic and powerful and it should be recognized not only for its quality but it's rich cultural contribution, including coffee served with the salt from Afar, where Lucy was found.

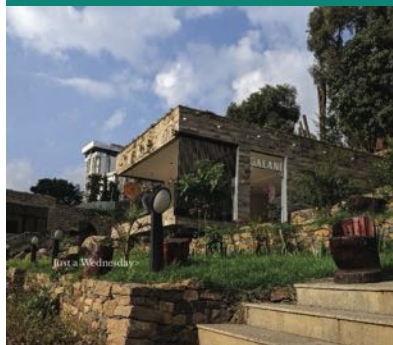

A NEW BEGINNING FOR NEWBORN CARE:

THE RENOVATED NICU AT TIKUR ANBESSA SPECIALIZED HOSPITAL OPENS IN ADDIS ABABA

In the heart of Addis Ababa, a renewed sense of hope now fills the corridors of one of Ethiopia's leading medical institutions. The Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) at Tikur Anbessa Specialized Hospital has officially reopened following major renovations, marking a significant milestone in the country's efforts to strengthen maternal and newborn healthcare.

The inauguration brought together health officials, medical staff and development partners who contributed to the transformation of the unit. Among the key supporters, the Italian Cooperation played a central role in upgrading the facility through improved infrastructure, modern neonatal equipment and enhanced care environments

designed to save the lives of the most vulnerable patients.

Inside the renovated NICU, upgraded incubators, advanced monitoring systems and improved care spaces have replaced outdated equipment. For healthcare workers, these changes represent far more than physical improvements—they signal renewed capacity to provide critical, life-saving care for premature and high-risk newborns.

Medical staff at Tikur Anbessa Specialized Hospital describe the transformation as both timely and essential. As demand for specialized neonatal services grows, the upgraded unit is expected to help reduce infant mortality and improve survival outcomes for newborns requiring intensive medical attention.

Beyond infrastructure, the initiative has also invested in training and capacity building, ensuring healthcare professionals can fully utilize the new systems and deliver high-quality neonatal care.

As the NICU reopens its doors, it stands not only as a renewed medical facility, but as a symbol of international partnership, resilience and a shared commitment to giving every newborn a stronger start in life.
