AUGUST 27 – SEPTEMBER 10, 2026

AN OCEAN OF NEW YEAR EXPERIENCES

ETHIOPIA HAS NEVER SEEN AN
EXPO QUITE LIKE ADEY EXPO.

Not simply because of its size, but because of what it finally brings together. For the first time on this scale, the many sides of a New Year celebration are placed under one roof, and given fifteen days to unfold. Created through the Always New concept, it takes a season that has always arrived scattered, and makes it whole.

There is a particular feeling that settles over Addis Ababa around the New Year. The air changes. Markets grow louder. Families start making lists. Somewhere between the last rains and the first yellow meskel flowers, the whole city seems to lean forward, waiting for something to begin.

New Year has always brought many things with it. Music, shopping, gatherings, food, fashion, culture, entertainment, business, and time with family. But usually these arrive scattered. A concert here. Shopping there. A cultural celebration somewhere else across town. Different parts of the city preparing for the same season, without ever becoming one experience.

SEPTEMBER 2026

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THIS YEAR, THAT CHANGES

Walk in and it does not feel like a traditional expo. It feels like stepping into an ocean of experiences. Grand Concerts carry the sound of the season, from Tsegaye Eshetu, a legend whose voice has shaped generations of New Year, to Skat Nati, a young rapper speaking for a generation raised on something newer, to Eden Aysheshum, a young and beloved voice of her own. Three different sounds, three different ages, one stage. From there the Grand Concerts open into a classic car exhibition. Comedy shares the air with arts and culture. Fashion, books, and dance each pull you a different direction, while more than 250 businesses form a commercial centre of their own at the heart of it. Turn a corner during Cultural Day, or bring the family through on Family and Children's Day, and there is a play area waiting, running the whole way through. One part leads into another, and something new is always just ahead of where you are standing.

None of it happens all at once, and that is the point. Fifteen days is what makes the ocean possible instead of a single overwhelming afternoon. Businesses get fifteen days to actually meet their customers, not just greet them once. Families get fifteen days to come back for the part they missed. The celebration itself gets room to breathe, to change day to day, to still be unfolding a week in.

For those who want to be inside it for the full stretch, VIP and VVIP packages are available through ArifPay. The VIP package is 5,000 birr, and the VVIP package is 7,500 birr, both built around the entire fifteen day festival, so being there is never limited to a single visit.

At its heart, Adey Expo is still an expo. Businesses, products, and customers remain its foundation. But around that foundation now sits a celebration large enough to hold everything the season carries. The air still changes over Addis Ababa this time of year. The markets still grow louder, the lists still get made. This year, for fifteen days, there is finally one place for all of it to arrive.

CELEBRATING ETHIOPIAN CHEF FARIYAL ABDULLAHI



Chef Fariyal Abdullahi, an acclaimed culinary talent of Ethiopian ancestry, has been selected to create exclusive inflight meals for United Airlines' international business-class passengers. For Fariyal, the partnership offers a platform to share her unique culinary perspective shaped by her heritage and training with millions of international travelers at 35,000 feet.

Fariyal Abdullahi was born in Addis Ababa and states that her mother was the greatest cook and her inspiration. The youngest of six, Fariyal had a lot to live up to. Her older siblings went on to become doctors and surgeons, and she was expected to follow in their path. But growing up in Ethiopia, spoiled by her mother's exceptional home cooking, Abdullahi fell in love with big family dinners, weekly trips to the market, and time spent in the kitchen. She moved to the United States for college, earning a bachelor's degree before her passion for cooking took over. At 25, Abdullahi decided to enroll in culinary school.

Today, Fariyal is the Executive Chef of the renowned New York restaurant Hav & Mar (owned by fellow Ethiopian origin chef Marcus Samuelsson) and she is one of 11 world-renowned chefs from four continents chosen to curate regionally inspired dishes for United's Polaris business class. Her cooking is described as a convergence of her travels and Ethiopian ancestry, brought to life with an infusion of European technique and flavors.

Fariyal has had quite an illustrious international career thus far and she is still not yet 41! Abdullahi uses her platform to spotlight other chefs and women of color through collaboration events and she launched the non-profit, 'Take Care of Home' that builds schools and gives access to water for families in rural Ethiopia. This year, they have begun construction of their seventh school.

SIMPLE HAWAIIAN CHICKEN SALAD (NO COCONUT)



INGREDIENTS

1 large chicken breast
 1/4 cup pineapple juice
 1 tbsp soy sauce
 1 tbsp ketchup
 2 garlic cloves, minced
 Zest of 1 lime
 1/4 tsp each paprika, cumin, onion powder, ginger powder, and salt
 4 cups chopped lettuce
 1/2 avocado, sliced
 1/2 red onion, sliced
 1/2 cup cherry tomatoes, halved
 1/2 cup corn
 1/2 cup pineapple chunks
 1 cup cooked white rice (optional)
 Dressing
 1½ tbsp lime juice
 2½ tbsp olive oil
 2 tbsp chopped cilantro (optional)
 1 garlic clove, minced
 1/2 tsp honey or sugar
 Salt and black pepper to taste

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Mix pineapple juice, soy sauce, ketchup, garlic, lime zest, and spices. Marinate chicken for at least 30 minutes (or overnight).
2. Cook chicken in a skillet with a little oil for 5–6 minutes per side until done. Slice.
3. Sear the pineapple and corn for 2–3 minutes.
4. Whisk together all dressing ingredients.
5. Arrange lettuce, tomatoes, onion, avocado, corn, pineapple, and rice (if using). Top with sliced chicken and drizzle with the dressing. Serve immediately.

CELEBRATING MESKEREM AND THE ETHIOPIAN NEW YEAR



September and particularly the Ethiopian month of Meskerem that runs from 11 September -10 October marks the beginning of the Ethiopian year. The countryside is filled with bright yellow 'Meskel' daisies (Adey Abeba) and sunshine is seen flickering through the rain clouds.

What are the celebrations for the Ethiopia New Year? It's not only a national holiday but a feast day and families will celebrate the New Year together on September 11, 'Enkutatash' as the day is called. They will visit and be visited by close friends and relatives.

It is closely followed by Meskel, which is celebrated nationally. Across the country, bonfires (Demera) are erected around a central pole that holds a cross and are decorated with the Meskel flowers. In Addis Ababa, the bonfires are lit on the night before Meskel, 26 September or Meskerem 16. A huge bonfire is set up in Meskel Square but every neighbourhood, roundabout and street corner has their own bonfires.

The fires are lit and the direction which the cross falls is said to predict the success of that year's harvest. Meskel day itself, September 27, is also a public holiday, and families will again celebrate with a feast at home.

Meskel (which means cross) is a ceremony that commemorates the Finding of the True Cross. In 326 AD, Empress Helena, mother of Constantine the Great, was guided by a dream to light a fire and follow the smoke to find the True Cross. The smoke rose high in the sky and descended at the point where she found the Cross.

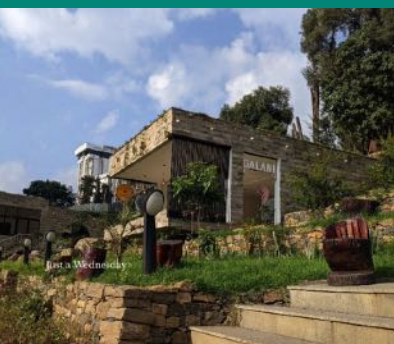

WHY FAMILY SUPPORT IS THE BEST CHILD PROTECTION

When Yimegnushal should have been thinking about school, she was thinking about whether her family would be okay. Her mother, Belaynesh, was doing everything she could. Living in Arba Minch with three children and an unpredictable household income, she stretched every bit of income as far as it could go. Some days there was enough food, and some days there wasn't. Worry became part of their daily life. Yet the greatest threat to the family wasn't a lack of love, but a lack of support.

When Belaynesh connected with a family and community strengthening programme run by SOS Children's Villages in Ethiopia, she received business training, parenting support, and access to savings opportunities. Her children also received educational support and life skills training. With her first loan, Belaynesh invested in an injera-selling business that now provides a stable income for her family. The result was not just a stronger livelihood but also a stronger family.

For many people, SOS Children's Villages in Ethiopia is known for providing care to children who have lost parental care or are at risk of losing it. But experience has shown that when families receive support early enough, many separations caused by financial hardship, crisis, illness, or a lack of support can be prevented.

That is why an increasing part of SOS Children's Villages in Ethiopia's work focuses on strengthening families and communities before they reach a breaking point.

Because the best way to help a child is not always by finding them a new home.

THE NOSTALGIC OLD TEA ROOM IN PIASSA

The Tea Room on Haile Selassie Street in Piassa has been an iconic landmark pastry and tea house since 1952. It is famous for introducing modern café culture, offering traditional Ethiopian black tea, and serving vintage-style pastries.

The Tea shop emerged during a period of modernization in Piassa, an area originally developed with modernist architecture in the 1930s and is closely linked to the early introduction of Italian-influenced pastries and social gathering habits in the capital.

It remains a living piece of Addis Ababa's heritage maintaining a heritage vibe amidst the city's ongoing corridor development, frequented by families, couples, friends meeting up and diaspora visiting the place they fondly remember frequenting.

The restaurant is upstairs serving pasta, pizza and traditional fare and the cafe is downstairs serving coffee, drinks and pastries.

For a sense and taste of nostalgia, it is well worth a visit!

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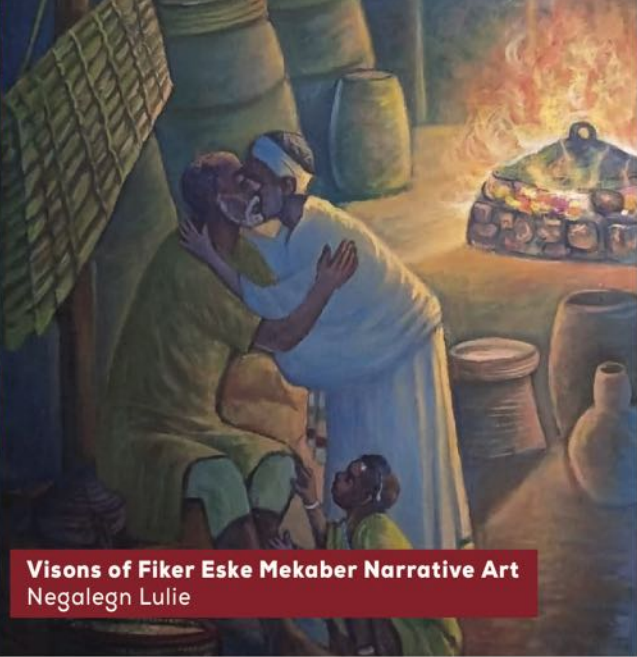

ACCLAIMED EAST AFRICAN SCI-FI ROMANCE SCREENED IN ADDIS



VideoBet, Ethiopia's first arthouse cinema and film center, recently screened *Memory of Princess Mumbi*, an acclaimed Kenyan-Swiss science-fiction film utilising AI tools to demonstrate the immense creative potential of young African storytellers. The film was written, directed, and produced by 25-year-old prodigy Damien Hauser, who also served as editor and cinematographer.

Memory of Princess Mumbi has been launched across five East African countries simultaneously, with the goal of building a vibrant, connected regional cinema culture where moviegoers can celebrate groundbreaking homegrown stories together on the big screen. The film first made waves internationally at prestigious global festivals including Venice Days, Toronto (TIFF), and BFI London.

Set in a resurrected African kingdom in the year 2093, *Memory of Princess Mumbi* is a retro-futuristic sci-fi romance mockumentary about love, memory, and human connection. In 2093, European documentary filmmaker Kuve visits the African coastal realm of Umata for a project covering the effects of a major war that occurred in the 2070s. Neighboring regions, seeking to ban depression among their populations, have banned computer technology and reinstated traditional kingdoms as a form of governance. Mumbi, one of the locals Kuve recruits for his documentary, challenges him and his crew to make a film free of artificial intelligence. Kuve falls in love with Mumbi, but she is betrothed to Prince, ruler of a neighbouring kingdom. Six years later, Mumbi, now a princess reunites with Kuve, where unresolved romantic tensions unfold during the production of his new blockbuster.

As part of Bigger Motion's long-term regional vision, the company is also actively exploring opportunities to bring Ethiopian feature films into its broader East African distribution network, creating a two-way cultural pipeline between Addis Ababa, Nairobi, Kigali, and beyond.

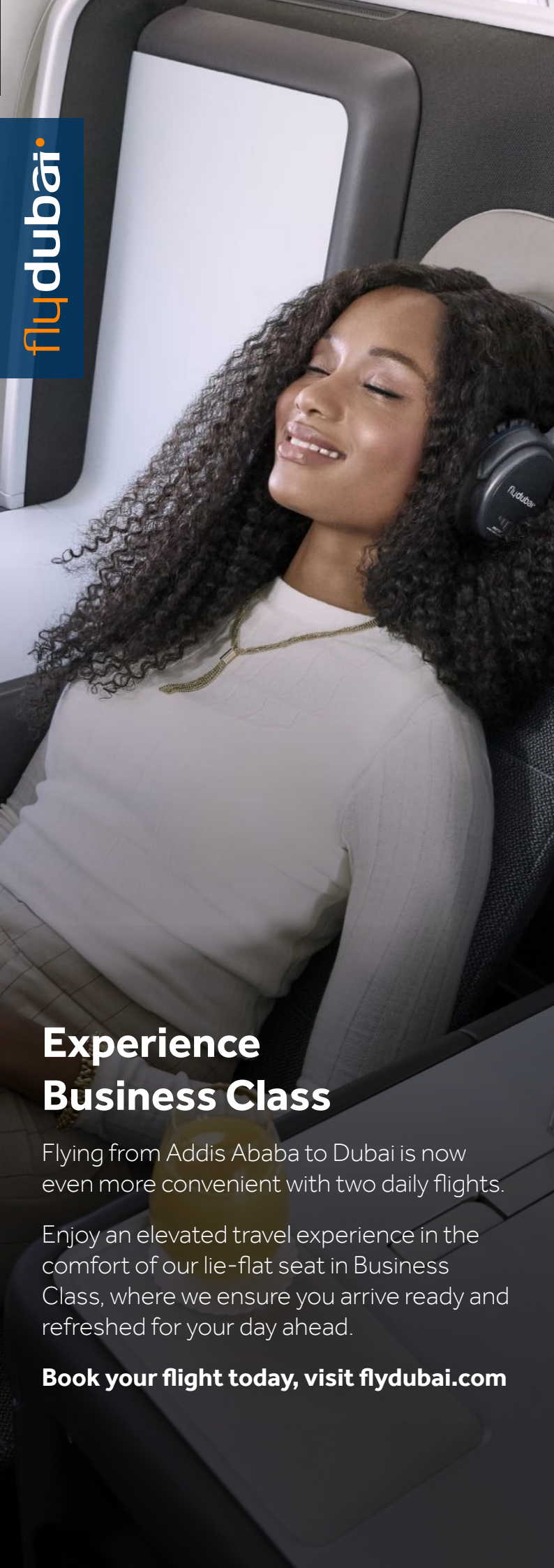
